As I have stated many times before, the mission given to the President and the Board is two-fold: Keep the American Spaniel Club fiscally strong and

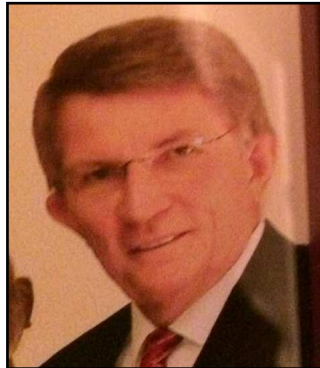

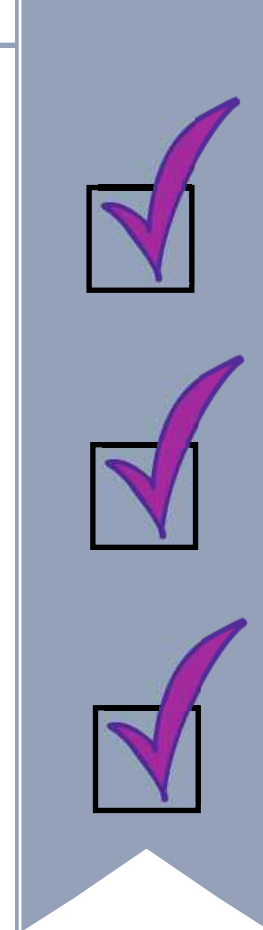

HAVE WE HIT ROCK BOTTOM?

A CENTURY OF NUMBERS

Do not kill the messenger. There is no sugar coating the fact: cocker spaniel registrations for 2015 are as low as the 1930s. **For 2015 the estimate is for 3,750 cockers!** The AKC has the Cocker Spaniel holding to #30 as the USA Top Dogs for 2014. And for the year 2015 there isn't much change in total registrations. This is the good news. For almost three years in a row the registration number will remain the same, halting a stunning 25 years decline.

Cocker Spaniels ranked number one from 1936-1953. Beagles attained top spot after that from 1954-1959. Poodles would become the most popular breed, reigning from 1960 for the next twenty-two years until 1982. Cocker Spaniels made a comeback and were number one again from 1983-1990, making them the dog with the longest total reign in the top spot at 25 years. In 1991, the Labrador retriever took over and remains the leader of the pack today for the 24th consecutive year, continuing the longest reign as the USA's top dog in AKC history. In 2002 cockers were 15th and continued to plunge to 16th in 2006, to 17th in 2007 and 23th in 2009.

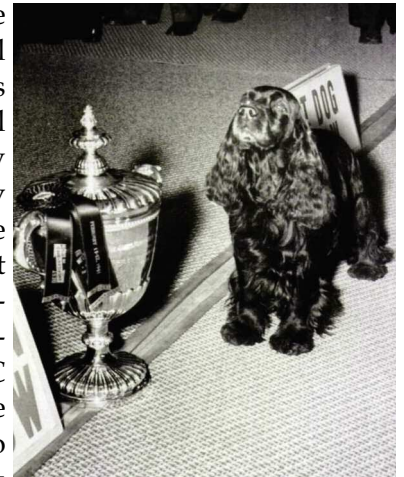
AKC's peak year for registrations was 1992 with approximately 1.5 million dogs. By 2010, the total annual AKC dog registrations were 563,611. This is an astounding 63% decrease.

How many Cocker Spaniels are registered in the USA today? Since 2009 AKC does not publish this statistic. But there are ways to estimate the numbers.

MORE THAN NUMBERS

Looking at the last one hundred years of cocker spaniel registrations, you can see 2 peaks (Figure 1): 1947-48 and 1990-91.

From 1920 the American Spaniel Club gave its Specialty at the Hotel Roosevelt in New York early January each year. And the Cocker Spaniel parent Club's annual rendezvous grew in reputation. In 1923 ASC introduced the Futurity Stake to encourage breeding better Cocker Spaniels. In 1925 ASC had about 65 members and more than 400 by 1945 and over 600 by 1959. The popularity of the Cocker spaniel quintuples between 1920 and 1930; this fame was helped when W.T. Payne's Ch. Midkiff Seductive was Best in Show at Westminster in 1921.



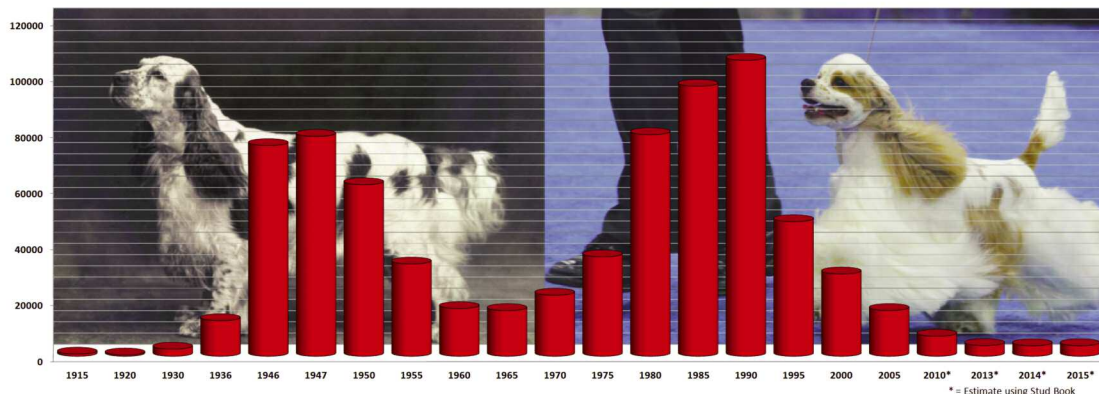

We Have Hit Rock Bottom...(continued)

This momentum continued with a first peak in cocker spaniel registrations following the popular wins of Ch. My Own Brucie. He won Best in Show at Westminster in 1940. It was a great boost to the breed popularity when the next year he went back and repeated his sensational triumph; everybody wanted a dog just like him! Brucie was the best known dog in America. When he passed away, the New York Evening Sun published his obituary on its first page, crowding out WWII news to make room for it.

"GENTLEMAN, I'VE SAID IT BEFORE, AND I CAN'T BE TOO EMPHATIC ABOUT IT-THE FIRST PERSON TO PUT AN ELECTRIC CLIPPER ON A COCKER WILL BE THE MAN TO START THE BREED'S DOWNFALL. ARE COCKER PEOPLE GOING TO BE BREEDERS OR BARBERS?"

UP AND DOWN AND UP AGAIN

The Cocker downward spiral began around 1948. "Breeder or barber" was a hot topic back then. The blacks generally had longer hair coat and were winning. Ruth M. Kraeuchi wrote: "A few heavy-coated individuals appeared, achieved great success in the ring and were tremendously bred to. This type is characterized by a taller, even more compact animal, with an accentuated stop, higher dome, a shorter deeper muzzle, more slope to the topline, a higher tailset and, of course, greater quantities of feathering – growing all over the leg and body and requiring extensive trimming and shaping(...). In 1957 the standard's description of coat was changed from "well-feathered" to "well-feathered, but not so excessively as to hide the Cocker Spaniel's true line(...)" in 1973 the standard was rewritten with particular emphasis on size, coat texture and mark-

ings(...) is the Cocker bred to fit the standard or is the standard changed to fit the cocker?"

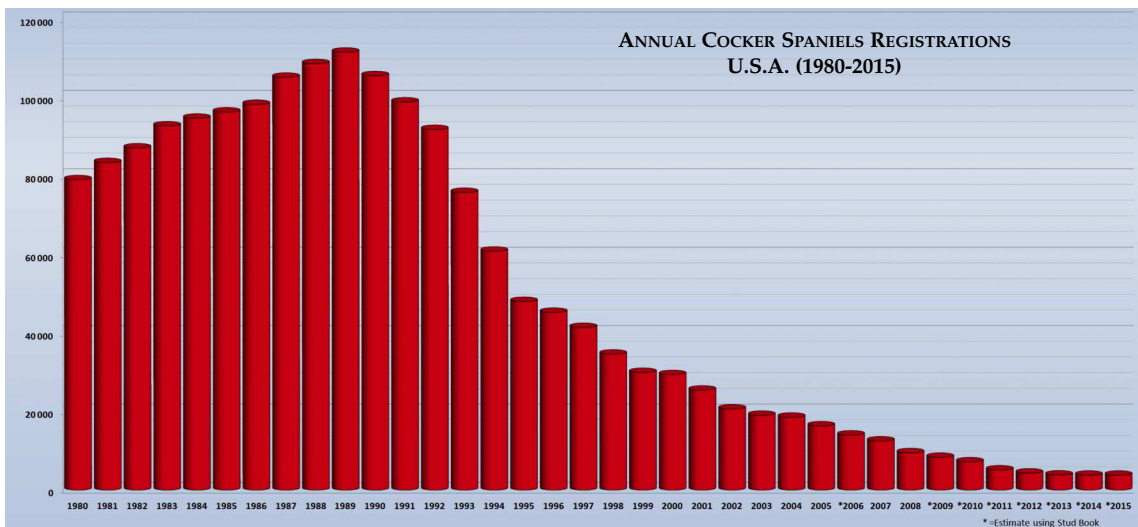
In 1959 Clark C. Thompson ASC Past Chairman Executive Committee wrote:" (...) no breed long remained at the peak for the reason that such over popularity attracts many types of breeders, vastly different from those who build the breed up its position of prominence. The new types are primarily "in" the breed solely for profit and have little if any interest in breeding as a study. Naturally when such appear in growing numbers, the breed starts to decline in overall quality and consequently drops off in popularity until those who were the cause of this falling off quickly look around for another breed that seems to be advancing in public favor."

In 1955 Walt Disney released the animated feature film Lady and the Tramp, and 10 years later dedicated breeders went on to improve the breed so that after 1965, the breed popularity started up again. The second peak was achieved gradually and by 1989-90 the Cocker was at the top of AKC registration with over 118,000 cockers.

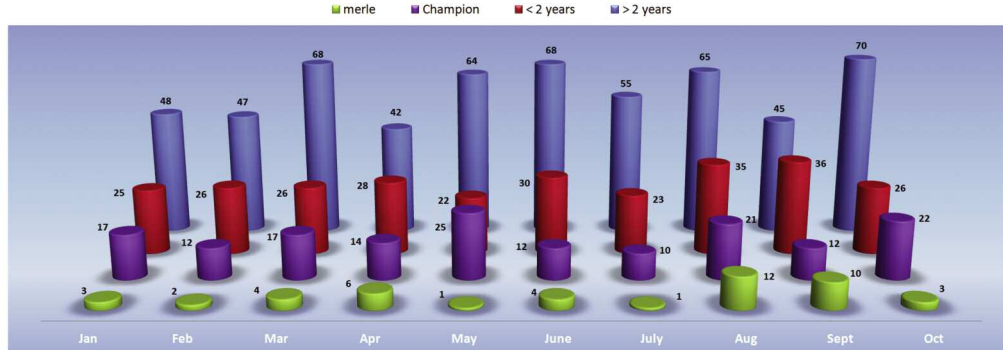
A BREED IN DANGER?

Breeders that helped the breed in the early and mid-sixties have retired and puppy-mills have moved-on to other breeds. The drop in registration is extreme (Figure 2).

In Great Britain, the Kennel Club recognizes a vulnerable breed as one which achieves 300 or fewer registrations each year. The Clumber spaniel, the Sussex spaniel, the Field spaniel and 25 other breeds are on that list. AKC has not published any registrations data since 2009, so it is impossible to know the accurate numbers of cockers registered. With the Stud Book, it is possible to estimate registrations; the good news is the decline is drastically slowing down since 2013. The last known number was 9,481 cock-

ers registered in 2008. For 2015 the estimate is for 3,750 cockers.

The number of Cocker Champions (Conformation Shows) remains the same. In 2013 there were 403 Champions and in 2014 there were 373 Champions. So far for 2015 the number is 336 (including Nov. 2015) and will probably reach 360 Champions. 10 years ago in 2005 there were 613 Champions.

Cockers in Obedience (CD, CDX, UD, UDX) remain low at 40 titles for 2014, about the same for 2012 and 2013 which is 41 and 40 respectively. There were 67 obedience titles won in 2005.

Rally Trials have been decreasing from a peak of 195 Rally titles (RN, RA, RE, RAE) in 2007 to only 75 in 2014. The number of cocker participating at agility trials has increased a little; this is difficult to compare as more and more titles are added every now and then. In 2014 there were 84 MACH titles, 33 NA, 34 NAJ and 46 MXP.

Field and hunting titles (JH, SH and MH) totaled 11 for 2014 compared to 19 in 2013. Tracking (TD, TDX) remain constant at 15 titles for 2014.

2015 STATISTICS

An excellent source for accurate information is the AKC Stud Books. While “Modern” Stud Books no longer record registered cockers, they document the first time any registered dog (male or female) is used to breed a registered litter of purebred dogs.

It is an indication of the future of the breed. It is a clue as to the number of dogs being born.

Up to and including October 2015 (Figure 3), every month there is on average 85 new dogs in the Stud Book. A lot of them are from recognized breeders, some are coming from distant countries and some are coming from less popular breeders with hardly any Champions for the first 4 or 5 generations. The highest month so far was August 2015 with 100 dogs and the lowest was 70 dogs in April 2015. Of those 85 dogs on average, 33% are under 2 years old. On average 5% are merles (SZ registration) and 19% are Champion

10 years ago in 2005, the monthly average was 427 new dogs per month of which 45% were under 2 years old.

As the registration number remains the same or continues to go down there will be few breeders left and breed diversity might be lost.

The cocker spaniel is a dog of superb disposition. The character of this small sporting dog hinges on his love of people. He is an ideal family dog adaptable to city living as well as large house with open grounds.

Both Kay and her late husband Larry Hardy had been long term breeders of cockers. In their later years, both Kay and Larry became popular AKC judges as well.

In 2007, Kay and husband Larry were honored by the American Spaniel Club, being inducted into its Hall of Fame. It was a well deserved honor following many years of contributions to our breed.

Kay continued to follow cocker news right up to the end of her life. Over the past 10 years, osteoporosis consumed her body, causing it to be greatly hunched over, but she still made it to the New England Breeders Xmas party each year, and an occasional dog show now and then. Her mind remained razor sharp. She drew the logo Hob Nob Hill Cockers - showing her artistic ability to great advantage. I happily have a signed and framed, limited edition drawing Michael Allen did of Ch. Hob Nob Hill's Tribute aka "Nicky" owned by Dr. Larry Smith. Tribute is behind the majority of buffs and blacks in the ring today ... a lasting legacy for sure. If I'm not mistaken Charlotte and Terry Stacy handled for them, along with Ted Young ... and at the end Wilson and Bonnie Pike. When judging, I recall Kay being a sucker for a pretty head. In her day, she truly was "the force" behind New England Breeder's Club. I also recall reading that the origin of their kennel name originated as a tribute to

a period in their life when they lived and worked in the San Francisco area.

At one Christmas party I was sitting at the table with Kay. - maybe 7 years ago. No one was making an attempt to include Kay in the table conversation. Me being me, didn't like that. So I asked Kay how Tribute came to be owned by Dr. Larry Smith. If you could have seen Kay ... her eyes suddenly went from glazed to sparkling. She told the wonderful story how that came to be - fondly calling the dog Nicky - and what he was like as a puppy. My only regret that evening was that I had not taken notes of what she shared. For me it was a most special evening. Kay had shared so beautifully the knowledge behind the making of this beautiful and influential dog she bred - Ch. Hob Nob Hill's Tribute. I left that evening feeling I had been handed a Xmas present early that year. Thank you Kay Hardy.

THE JOURNEY TO PET THERAPY...

THE ROAD LESS TRAVELED
CONTINUES!!!

DeeDee is proud to be a certified therapy dog

DeeDee's journey to pet therapy has ended, and we have met our goal to have her certified by the end of 2015. She PASSED the TDI, Therapy Dog International, therapy dog test on September 8, 2015! What an exciting night that was for me; she just acted excited because I was! The journey to pet therapy may have ended with the passing of the TDI therapy dog test, but her journey as a certified therapy dog has just begun. She has not been on a therapy visit yet since we are waiting for the ID card, but by the time you read this article we will be visiting four facilities (hospital, retirement resort, assisted living, and nursing home). We are still taking our field trips to ride elevators as well as walk through as many different doors as possible. For example, almost all the facilities have the doors that operate by pushing a button and swing wide open to accommodate a wheelchair, walker, or someone who can't open the door on their own. These doors just come out with a force, and she is getting used to those as well. The sliding door is also an entrance especially

at hospitals, and we even have a revolving door to master. Going up and down flights of stairs is also on our list of things to practice since we live in a one story home. She does better with stairs than I do!

The therapy dog test was held at the Oklahoma City Obedience Training Club where I belong and where I had taken her for classes. We had approximately 15 dogs registered to evaluate that evening, and since I cannot evaluate my own dog, we were in the first group so I could help with the following groups. The TDI test is done partly in a group and partly individual. The group test consists of four dogs, and they perform the behaviors as a group in some of the areas. DeeDee was dog #1 in the first group of four, and even though I knew she could meet the requirements, I was still somewhat nervous that we might not work well enough as a team to pass. DeeDee, on the other hand, did not seem one bit worried about it; in fact, she seemed very calm and settled. She was not in the least bothered by the 125 lb dog that was waiting his turn to test or the dog that towered over her in size. I had seen this kind of confidence in her when she was in class with seven large dogs and she was the only small dog there. It certainly helped me know that she was not shy or fearful. That was very important to our journey.

Once the test started with the dogs in a down position and the handler filling out the necessary papers, everything went pretty fast. After the papers were filled out and the evaluator had them in her clipboard, we began by having a volunteer come to our chair and take our dog's leash. The handlers went out of sight for one minute and came back to take charge of their dog. Dee was just fine with the volunteer she had and so were the other dogs. So far so good! As a group we had a sit stay and a down stay. Our dogs were about eight feet apart and that gave plenty of room for each team. The other three dogs and handlers left the ring to a waiting area right outside the ring while dog #1 (Dee) was tested on heeling with medical distractions, walking on a loose lead, being petted by

several people using medical equipment, walking by a food bowl with food and a water bowl with water, leaving a treat alone that was being offered to her by a person in a wheelchair, having a stranger with a dog coming walking toward us and coming when called. All of these things were done with only the two of us in the ring. We waited outside the ring while each of the other three dogs, one at a time, went through the same behaviors. After all four dogs in the group had done the individual tests, we all went back inside the ring, and the dogs sat at the handler's left while children ran and played in the ring across from us. They were to remain seated and not show aggression or become extremely excited. DeeDee had no problem with that thanks to neighbors with a trampoline right next to our fence and children always jumping and laughing. Sometimes the best distractions are those you live by or live with. The children continued to play and laugh while the dog was on a down position with their backs to the children and the handler read a book aloud. This exercise lasted about a minute. It was over before I knew it, and the nerves were calmed for me as soon as we began because I could see my sweet, confident Dee was just fine with everything. She was herself, and I also know that

she will enjoy getting to visit and be petted and loved by others.

The two other evaluators congratulated each of the first four teams, and I was so excited and thankful to have another dog that wants to be around people and wants to be petted so we can make a difference in someone's day. It still brings tears to my eyes to know Dee is given a chance to share her personality and love with others and that she has earned that right by learning how to behave, but most of all, because she has the correct temperament and love inside her. She deserves to be a therapy dog.

After her group was finished, the others were dismissed and could leave if they wanted to, but DeeDee had to sit in the wire crate I brought her and wait until I finished evaluating the rest of the dogs

that were there. She watched everything since she had the best seat (bed) in the house. It took about two hours more to finish the rest of the people that were waiting, but being able to wait calmly in a busy facility is also something that is important. One of the facilities I visit is a nursing home that has a birthday party for the residents each month, and I help with that while my therapy dog waits in a crate for the pet therapy visit that follows. It is important that they can "chill" and wait without whining and barking. DeeDee never made a sound while she waited

that length of time after the test. I had fed her only part of her dinner because fouling the ring or area is an automatic dismissal from the test. She ate the other half in the crate so I'm sure that helped to make it a good place to be!

Since passing the TDI test, Dee has been spayed, visited a new grooming salon, gone on more field trips, taken more obedience classes, and been to another photo shoot with Suzie and MiMi. Since all three of them are therapy dogs, I wanted to have their pictures made together with the TDI scarves and tags. I also wanted to have Dee's picture made with Sydnee as well as for her ID photo. Candi Telford Photography is who takes my dogs' pictures, and she is so patient with everything. She specializes in newborn photos, and she tells me that the dogs are so much easier! I'm not sure I would agree after it took my daughter, Sydnee and me to get all the pictures I wanted from the shoot. When LadyBug was alive, she was a true alpha, but very silent about it. She never had to remind them of anything. Everyone just did what they were supposed to, but now it is really Suzie's turn to be alpha, but she'd rather just be one of the "gang"! Suzie should be alpha and Dee thinks she is. MiMi is just satisfied to be there with them and have a good time. I've made a decision

that has seemed to help solve the problem somewhat. There will be no canine alpha; I am the alpha! They really like it that way especially Suzie.

This is the last of the series of articles on Dee's journey to pet therapy, but I will showcase one of her first pet therapy visits in the next article. Being a therapy dog is a journey of its own. In this article, I'm sharing the pictures from our photo shoot. I'm so proud of my three therapy dogs. They are solid in temperament and confident in themselves as well as always glad to see their "people". They all have tricks they love to do and they give obedience demonstrations. Their favorite part of the therapy visit is time with the residents or visitors that are at the facilities we visit. Sydnee is still a big part of our visits as she has permission to leave school early when those visits are planned.

A big thank you to Dee's breeders, Jan Taylor and Genea Jones, for breeding such a sweet girl, and to Jan Taylor for being Suzie and MiMi's breeder. Breeders never know just how much joy one of their "furkids" can bring to others. There is a feeling that I have about the dogs I have or have had.....I truly believe I have/ had the dogs I am supposed to have, and I also do not believe in coincidence. I consider pet therapy to be a form of ministry for me, and I am so thankful to have the dogs I do because of the breeders and the other breeders and dogs that have come before them.
