## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

Show grounds include the Iowa State Fairgrounds, Varied Industries Building, camping grounds and Motel/Hotel sites.

Entry to Fairgrounds through Grand Ave gate only.

No parking on south side next to Varied Industries Bldg - THIS IS A DESIGNATED FIRE LANE. No parking on the grass east or north of the Varied Industries Bldg. **All vehicle parking is controlled by the fairground police.**

Campers & trailers may park overnight behind the building in designated areas.

Grooming in designated area only. Hand held dryers are allowed in the designated grooming areas, too. NO GROOMING is allowed in the west half of the building or around Obedience rings. Obedience crating only around Obedience rings. This will be strictly enforced!!!

Exhibitors please note that the Iowa State Fair requires that only approved tape, such as gaffer tape, be used to tape down extension cords. Please follow up with the Reserved Grooming personnel at the show site in regards to approved tape.

Reserved Grooming \*\*\* Please note Reserved Grooming form for 2022 \*\*\* Please submit completed form with payment by the date listed on the form.

**NOTICE: Electricity is only available with reserved grooming. Electricity is \$30.00/plug. \*\*\*Cords without a tag will be unplugged...**

Crates must be stacked. No private ex-pens, cocker pens, puppy pens, rugs or mats allowed in the building. Designated aisles must be kept open!

Crates may be stacked in designated area of center aisle only during the time that breed is being judged. Holding Ring will be available for Toy breeds, but no crates may remain in the area except for time of judging. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

**There will be no roping off or saving of grooming spaces inside the building or parking spaces outside building.**

Entries received prior to the published opening date and time of entries or received prior to the publishing of this premium list will be returned without processing.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.** The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks nor will they be accepted toward entry fees.

**HERDING TITLED BITCH CLASS** - For any bitch that has achieved an AKC Herding Title (HT, PT, HS, HI, HX, HCh). NO HIC. Entrants must be intact. Winners eligible to compete for Best of Breed.



### **NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. - Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four- to - Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

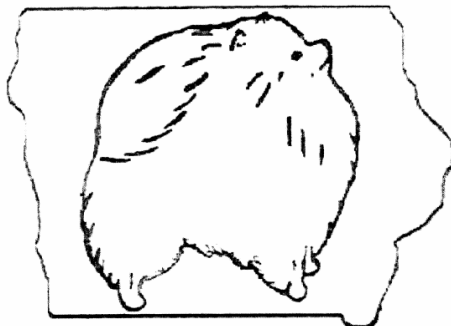
