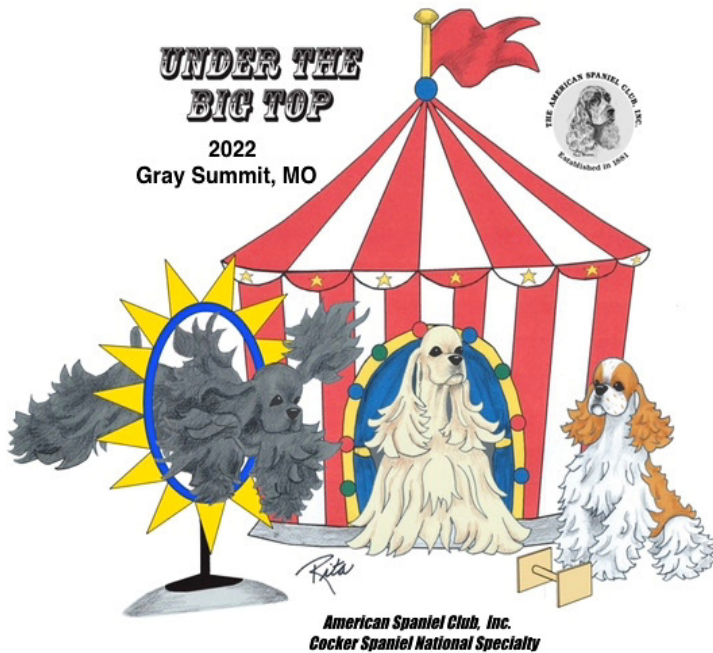

## Best of Breed / Variety Competition

### NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

#### Classes for Dogs and Bitches

**Veteran:** open to all dogs 7 years old and older

**Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8, of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males & spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Classes at specialty shows. *Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition.*

**Field Classes (National Only)** Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches that have earned working dog (WD) or working dog excellent (WDX) titles from their Parent breed clubs have received a qualifying score at any AKC Hunting Test for Flushing Spaniels or received a placement at an AKC Field Trial. Classes to be judged after Winners but before Best of Variety of Breed. *Winners to compete for Best of Variety if undefeated.*

### NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

#### National Only

**Stud Dog Class.** For stud dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud dog must be entered in the appropriate Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based upon their merits. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.



**Brood Bitch Class.** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. In accordance with AKC rule Ch 11, Sec 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch Class.

**Brace Class** - The entry fee for a Brace as a UNIT is \$35. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No 1", "Brace No 2", etc. ***Brace as an additional entry - \$25.00 for the unit.***

**Team Class** - Same as Brace Class, see information above and substitute "Team" for "Brace". - A team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner.

## Obedience Trials & Rally Trials

Dog means either sex • A dark green ribbon will be given for qualifying scores

Classes with jumps will be judged in ascending order beginning at 4"

Entries must include jump height for classes requiring jumps

"According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of AKC Regulations, entries will be limited. Each judge will be limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time per day." Obedience Trials will be limited as follows: Friday limited to 5 hours, Sunday limited to 6 hours. Rally Trials will be limited as follows: Friday limited to 50 entries, Sunday limited to 40 entries. When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX, Preferred UDX, and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Preferred Open or Preferred Utility class, the Preferred UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted.

## **Master Class**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.**

1. All dogs entered in the owner-handled sweepstakes must be entered in regular classes of the show.
2. The person handling the dog in the class must be an owner of record of the dog, and may not be a professional handler.
3. Judging in each sex and variety shall be as follows: 6-12 months, open and Champion classes
4. The winners of each variety sex and class group will compete for Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex in Variety
5. The three Variety winners will compete for Best Owner-Handled in Sweepstakes.
6. Any dog of the opposite sex to the Best Owner-Handled Sweepstakes, if undefeated within the Variety and sex, will compete for the Best of Opposite Sex to Best Owner-Handled in Sweepstakes.
7. The money received by ASC from the entries shall be divided as follows, after 30% has been retained by the club to help defray expenses.

## **CUT-DOWN SWEEPSTAKES RULES (National Only)**

1. All dogs entered in the cut-down sweepstakes must be eligible for the regular classes of the show.
2. To stimulate interest in showing pure bred Cocker Spaniels a cut-down sweepstakes shall be held in conjunction with, and as a special attraction of the American Spaniel Club National Specialty Show. The cut-down sweepstakes is not limited to members of the club but open to all Cocker Spaniel Exhibitors.
3. All dogs entered in the cut-down sweepstakes must be at least 1 year of age on the first date of the show.
4. No dogs may compete in the cut-down sweepstakes with more than 2 inches of feathering, not to include ears. Classes will be divided by sex and variety, but all ages will be shown together.
5. The club shall determine the entry fee. Entry monies received shall be distributed as follows, after 30% has been retained by the club to defray expenses:

6. If any prize money is not awarded for any reason it shall revert to the club.
7. The entry fee for each dog entered in the cut-down sweepstakes must accompany the entry stating cut-down sweepstakes in the class/additional class box on the entry form.

## **BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR SWEEPSTAKES RULES (National Only)**

1. Entry is open to all dogs and bitches at least 6 months of age and not over 12 months of age.
2. Entrants must be entered in a regular class.
3. The person handling the dog in the class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class becomes eligible there are no restrictions as to who may handle.
4. Judging in each sex and variety shall be as follows: 6-9 months and 9-12 months
5. The winners in each variety sex and age group will compete for Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety.
6. The three Best of Variety winners will compete for Best in Bred by Exhibitor Sweepstakes.
7. Any dog of the opposite sex to Best in Bred by Exhibitor Sweepstakes, if undefeated within their variety, shall compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Bred by Exhibitor Sweepstakes.
8. The money received by ASC from the entries shall be divided as follows, after 30% has been retained by the club to defray expenses:

**Judge-Ryan Wolfe**

*The Futurity Stake is a showcase for the breeder's effort*

BREEDERS OF ENTRIES for the Futurity MUST BE American Spaniel Club, Inc. ("ASC") members in good standing through all steps of the Futurity (have annual dues paid, no suspensions). Any suspension of a breeder or co-breeder by AKC and/or ASC shall automatically disqualify the breeder from participation in the Futurity, to include any nominations for bitches owned, co-owned or leased during the suspension and any puppies bred or co-bred during the suspension. This includes disqualifying any existing bitch nominations or puppy enrollments and also disallows any future bitch nominations or puppy enrollments during the suspension period. No puppy will be eligible for futurity enrollment from any litter which was bred or co-bred by a suspended member, regardless of ownership. Owners (if other than the breeder) of entries are not required to be ASC members.

Nominations and Enrollments shall be sent to the Futurity Chairman only on the forms issued by the ASC. You may photocopy the forms. The forms state the required payment and information. Incomplete forms will be returned. **Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds, (Checks drawn on U.S. Banks and U.S. Money Orders only). There will be no refunds. Checks on Foreign Banks for U.S. funds are not acceptable and if sent will be returned along with the Futurity Form.**

The steps which must be taken to Futurity nominate are as follows:

**1. Bitch Nomination.**

- a. The dam of the litter must be owned or leased by an ASC member(s).
- b. The dam must be properly nominated prior to whelping (between July 1 and December 31 inclusive).
- c. Only puppies from nominated bitches, whelped after date of nomination, are eligible.
- d. The nomination envelope must bear a post office cancellation stamp with a date prior to the whelping date. **Postage Meter is not valid.** If the postmark is not legible or is missing, the date mailed will be considered to be 2 days prior to receipt.
- e. A fee of \$10 for each bitch nominated must accompany the form, in accordance with the instructions stated on the form. If the bitch's due date is such that she may whelp in either the January or July Futurity, you should nominate her for both.
- f. Both sire and dam must be at least 2 years old before the breeding takes place.
- g. Health testing must be done after the sire and dam reach age 2 and before the breeding takes place.
- h. Eye exams must be done on or after age 2 and annually thereafter. Exams must be done not more than 12 months prior to the breeding unless the sire/dam is more than eight years old, in which case a clear exam after the age of eight will be accepted.
- i. Documents which must accompany the nomination form:
  - \* Photocopies of the individual registration certificates for both sire and dam.
  - \* Photocopies of certification of clear eyes from a Board Certified Ophthalmologist or similar designation in the case of foreign entries for both sire and dam.
  - \* Photocopies of OFA or Penn Hip certification for normal hips for both sire and dam or similar certification in the case of foreign entries for both sire and dam.

***If sire and/or dam are listed in the ASC Health Registry, it is not necessary to forward copies of the registration certificate, eye or hip certification for that animal. If certification for either eyes or hips is not listed in the Health Registry, a copy of that certification must be sent.***

If the bitch is leased, send photocopies of the AKC Registration and Lease Form filed with the AKC.

## **2. Puppy Enrollment.**

- a. Enrollment of any puppies must be made on or before **May 1**.
- b. Enrollments must be made on the form issued by ASC and a payment of \$10 per puppy is required.
- c. The form will state the complete requirements, but generally, the name of the puppy, the name of the sire and dam, date of birth, sex, variety and individual AKC Registration Number must be given. Canadian-bred or Mexican-bred puppies may provide a Canadian or Mexican Registration Number, if an AKC number is not yet obtained.
- d. d. Late Enrollment: You may make a late puppy enrollment for a TOTAL fee of \$25 per puppy, provided all other requirements are met. LATE ENROLLMENTS DO NOT GO BY POSTMARK. THEY MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CHAIRMAN BY JUNE 1 FOR JULY.

## **3. Entry.**

- a. Entries shall be made in the name of the OWNER (S), who need not be a member of ASC.
- b. A final payment of \$15 for each puppy to be shown shall be made to the Superintendent of the Show before the closing of entries for the Show, at which time the Name, AKC Number, Date of birth, Breeding, Sex and Variety of each puppy must be given on the Regular AKC approved Entry Blank, together with the payment of the Regular Entry Fee.
- c. Each puppy shall be entered in one of the Regular Classes and, in addition, the entry blank must also be designated "Futurity Stake."
- d. The BREEDER(S) of the puppy MUST STILL BE A CURRENT MEMBER OF ASC. The ASC is not responsible for any errors made on the Entry Blank and no refunds will be made by ASC.

The money received by ASC from the nomination of bitches shall be divided as follows: 40% for the expenses of the Futurity Stake, 10% for the Best Puppy in Futurity (50% of this will be awarded to the puppy's owner; 50% to the breeder), 5% for Best Opposite Sex to Best In Futurity Puppy (50% of this will be awarded to the puppy's owner, 50% to the breeder), 10% for Best Puppy in each Variety, 5% for Best Opposite Sex to Best in each Variety.

The money received by ASC from the puppy enrollments and the final payment in each sex, each age group, AND each Variety shall be divided as follows: 40% of the total for expenses for the Futurity Stake, and the remaining shall be divided among each sex, each age group, and among each Variety as follows: 25% to First, 20% to Second, 10% to Third, and 5% to Fourth.

The judging in each sex and Variety shall be as follows: 6 to 9 months; 9 months and over but not exceeding the age limitations of the Futurity. Each sex, each age group in each Variety shall be judged separately. Following the judging of each age and sex group of each Variety for best in each group above, the six shall be judged, first for best of each respective Variety, and Best Opposite Sex to each Variety, and from the final three shall be selected the Best Puppy in the Futurity. Any dog of opposite sex to Best in Futurity, if undefeated within their Variety, shall compete for Best Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity. The BREEDER of Best of each Variety and Best opposite Sex of each Variety shall receive a Certificate from the ASC.

Money awards will be payable in the ring to the person handling the dog.

Dogs and equipment will need to be removed by 9am on Monday, July 25, 2022

Name and contact information must be left of dog crates in case of emergency.

Private food or drink is not allowed in any Purina facility or competition area.

There will be NO SMOKING (including electronic cigarettes) within the confines of the building.

Sanitary conditions must be maintained in the show building and/or anywhere at the Purina Events Center at all times.

### **PLASTIC AND SHAVINGS WILL BE PROVIDED AND MUST BE USED UNDER ALL X-PENS.**

**Trash pick up will be approximately every 2 hours, see schedule at show.**

All exercise pens must be identified with the exhibitor's name. Exercise pens must be kept clean.

The show committee will monitor the cleanliness of the show building and reserves the right to request grooming areas to be cleaned at any time as deemed necessary. Dogs may not run off lead except in runs or fenced area provided by the Purina Events Center.

Bathing of dogs will be confined to the bathing area provided in the Purina Events Center. It is a privilege to use this area. Please keep it clean.

All dogs in the area around the Obedience and Rally ring must be crated or held on leads. Warm-up practices must be performed on lead.

## **PURINA GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS**

Purina Farms and the American Spaniel Club have placed the following guidelines and restrictions in place for the 2022 Cocker Spaniel National Specialty and Agility Trial. Anyone planning on attending this event will be required to comply with the following:

### **TACK ROOM AND GROOMING**

- The bathing area will be available for use, and ex-pens are allowed in Gateway Hall.
- Day crating for Agility exhibitors will be allowed adjacent to the Agility ring in the main show arena.
- Day crating for obedience/rally (if needed) will be located near the obedience/rally rings.

### **SHOW ARENA**

- The conformation, agility and obedience/rally rings will be laid out approximately the same as they have been for previous ASC National Specialty shows.
- Vendors will be located only along one wall to allow for the space between the agility and conformation rings to be used for agility crating.
- Catalog and memorabilia sales tables, and other tables used for fundraising will be allowed.
- **Reserved patron seating will be allowed with chairs to be provided by ASC.**
- Chairs will be provided by Purina for judges, stewards, the videographer and other show workers. Judges' education seating will be provided as needed.

### **PHOTOGRAPHER/VIDEOGRAPHER**

- Show Dog Video Pros will have tables and chairs for their use only at ringside.

### **FOOD/DRINK AND RESTROOMS**

- The Café will be open
- Attendees may only use restrooms on the main floor of the Purina Event Center. Restrooms on the upper level are restricted for use by Purina staff only.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

**PREFACE:** The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
