





In addition to the regular Flushing Spaniel Show judging there will also be several independent specialties hosted by the parent clubs of the other flushing spaniel breeds, as well as a Cocker Spaniel specialty.

When the ASC first reached out to the parent clubs of the other flushing spaniels in 2016 to gauge their interest in holding independent specialties during the Flushing Spaniel Show weekend, the goal was to expand interest and entries for all breeds. Despite the COVID pandemic and a reduction in entries nationwide at dog shows, we are pleased that the enthusiasm and participation for this show has grown in the past six years. look forward to working with all of you in the future to ensure the continuing success of this special event.

#### **ANNUAL MEETING**

The Annual Meeting and Reception will be held Saturday evening in the Marriott function room area. Details will be printed in the Judging Program. Each attendee will receive a ticket for a complimentary drink—wine, beer, soft drink, or water. Hard liquor and cocktails will also be available for cash purchase.

#### **ASC BOARD MEETING**

The American Spaniel Club will hold the winter board meeting on Thursday, January 12, 2023, and it is open to all members. The location will be printed in the judging program.

#### **BATHING**

The American Spaniel Club provides three bathtubs with warm water for use between 5:00 am and 9:00 pm in the tack room.

#### **CATALOG ADVERTISING**

Consider putting an announcement of upcoming specialty shows, advertisement of dog related products, or featured wins in the show catalog. The form is posted on the ASC website.

#### CATALOG SALES

Catalogs will be sold at the catalog table by Ring 1. Please help us keep money handling tasks to a minimum by paying for your catalog with \$20 cash.

#### COVID RESTRICTIONS

Everyone entering the show site will be required to have their temperature taken daily. Masks that cover the nose to below the chin are required to be worn inside except when eating or drinking. Should changes be made to the guidelines, they will be posted on the website and in the judging program.

#### **EARLY MORNING COFFEE/TEA**

The American Spaniel Club will offer complimentary coffee and hot tea for early risers beginning at 6:30 AM. We will also have a complimentary water station near the announcer's table.

#### **FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

The concession stand will be open for seven hours during the show. The menu will include snacks, drinks, sandwiches, salads, and hot soup. To reduce exchange of money to a minimum, be prepared to bring small bills and change with you. Please note outside food and beverages are not to be brought into the show site and there is a strict no alcohol policy for the facility.

#### **FUTURITY**

Not only will cocker spaniels have a Futurity, there will also be a Specialty show on Friday. Patty Darke, Frank Kane, Kathy Patterson and Marilyn Spacht (Best of Breed at Regional Specialty) will judge cockers in the specialty and Flushing Show.

#### **HOURS OF USE**

The facility will be unlocked at 5:00 am on Friday–Monday and will be locked at 11:00 pm Thursday–Sunday nights. All dogs and equipment are to be removed by 10:00 am on Monday, January 16, 2023.

#### **HOTELS**

There is a room block at the Marriott Knoxville Downtown (formerly the Holiday Inn Worlds Fair) upstairs from the show site. The hotel has had extensive renovations. The rooms have floor to ceiling windows and all beds are king-size. There is now an elevator that goes from all guest room floors down to the same level as the show site. There is a coffee shop off the lobby and there is also a game room with pool table, televisions, and more.

#### **JUDGES EDUCATION SEMINAR**

The following Judges Education Seminars are offered at the ASC Flushing Show on Friday, January 13, 2023 at the Marriott Downtown Knoxville (room details to be posted onsite): Cocker Spaniels – 9am; Field Spaniels – 11am; Boykin Spaniels – 1pm. #### **PARKING**

Parking is available at the host hotel. Self-parking is available for hotel guests at \$14/day and valet parking is available for \$28/day. Also, individuals attending the Flushing Spaniel Show may park in the hotel parking lot/garage for a fee of \$16/day.

#### PREMIUM LIST

Foy Trent Dog Shows is the show superintendent. The premium list will be published on the ASC website and Foy Trent's website at https://foytrentdogshows.com/upcomingshows.html.

#### **RAFFLE**

ASC will have a limited Silent Auction in addition to a raffle and other fundraising opportunities.

#### RINGSIDE SEATING

All ringside seats must be reserved. The reservation form will be posted on the website, but the reservation form cannot be postmarked prior to December 10, 2022

#### **SHOW STREAMING**

Dog Show Video Pros will video BOTH rings and will offer subscriptions for live streaming. More information will be posted on the website. Individuals are prohibited from streaming during the show.

#### **SMOKING**

The entire facility is a No Smoking area.

#### **TACK ROOM**

Upon arrival, check-in with Marlene Ness, Tack Room Chair; exhibitors may begin moving in Thursday at 6:30 AM. Bring plastic sheeting and shavings to put under your ex-pens. There may be a few 5' X 10' spaces allocated for exhibitors with 1 or 2 dogs. There will be an area for day crating but there will be no electricity available. The grooming space reservation form will be posted on the website and printed in the premium list.

#### **UNLOADING**

There is a small area for unloading at the far end of the building. Please unload your vehicle as quickly as possible and then move to a parking area before setting up. Marshalls will be on duty to keep traffic moving. Do not park in front of the building to unload. This is a driveway that can quickly get congested and city police do patrol the area and issue citations.



## The Little Cocker Who Could

IN A QUIET CORNER OF THE PURINA EVENTS CENTER ON THE FINAL DAY OF THE ASC NATIONALS, ONE OF THE WEEKEND'S MOST MAGICAL MOMENTS TOOK PLACE.





That afternoon, Cherry Pie, a/k/a Rowlett's Sakura Hime UDX5 OM3 VER RE, and her owner/handler Stella Rowlett wrapped up their OTCH (Obedience Trial Champion title) while also finishing High Combined and High in Trial—marking a major milestone in the career of the diminutive superstar and her intrepid owner/handler.

What were the odds of this little Cocker, with her challenging history, rising through the ranks to become the #1 obedience Cocker Spaniel in the country? The odds were slim at best, but Cherry Pie's story is one of courage and determination and the love and dedication of her human. Their extraordinary accomplishments made Cherry Pie's induction into the American Spaniel Club Hall of Distinction a shoo-in in 2018.

As Jeanne Grim, co-chair of ASC's Top Dog Committee and keeper of the club's performance statistics, explains, "Cherry Pie is only the 13th Cocker Spaniel to earn the OTCH title since AKC introduced it in 1977. It is earned by placing against all other dogs in the class, and that is often very hard because smaller dogs like Cockers must compete and place against the Golden Retrievers, Labradors, and Collies. On top of that, Cherry Pie was Stella's Novice A—or first obedience dog. To take your Novice A dog all the way to an OTCH is an amazing achievement!"

Now consider that, at 12 weeks of age, Cherry Pie had been hit by a car in a supermarket parking lot, resulting in a serious fracture to her femur. Her owner at the time made the decision to euthanize her, but Dr. Susan Min and Terrolynn Guiles came to the rescue and saw to it that the puppy had the necessary surgery and foster care.

Though Stella and her husband Jonathan, who live in Redmond, Washington, had always thought two dogs were their limit, they changed their minds when they met and fell in love with Cherry Pie at Terrolynn's house in July of 2010. She joined



their household when the original adopter had to renege for personal reasons.

Stella had unsuccessfully tried obedience with one of her other two rescue Cockers, Louie. She almost immediately sensed Cherry Pie and obedience would be a perfect fit, and that belief was born out when the seven-month-old puppy made her debut in AKC sports with a qualifying score in AKC rally the same week she graduated from puppy classes. Before the age of two, she finished her Companion Dog title with a High in Trial win at the Rose City Cocker specialty. She completed her Companion Dog Excellent title in October of 2013 after two knee surgeries.

Stella wasn't even thinking about continuing on in Utility Obedience. "But, despite her green handler, Cherry Pie mastered the exercises so quickly," she laughs, "we just had to keep going!"

In 2015, they finished her Utility Dog title right before her fifth birthday. In 2016, she qualified for the 2017 AKC National Obedience Championships (NOC) as the #1 Cocker in the country and finished her Utility Dog Excellent title in January of 2017, which secured her induction into the ASC Hall of Distinction. But, sadly, injuries to both Cherry and Stella prevented their participation in the 2017 NOC.

Several vets told Stella the little dog's injury was career-ending, but Stella had her own ideas. She knew Cherry's courage, and so, after a series of stem cell treatments, the team resumed regular trialing, and Cherry repeated as top Cocker for 2017.

2018 and 2019 found the team sidelined by Stella's professional and personal commitments, and 2020 presented its own challenges, including COVID and a cancer diagnosis for Stella's other dog, Heidi. But Cherry did accomplish her UDX #11 and was selected as cover girl for Front and Finish magazine for her 10<sup>th</sup> birthday.


## From Deb Sazma, ASC National Obedience and Rally, CGC, and Trick Chair:

It was my special privilege and joy to oversee the Obedience competition when Cherry Pie and her owner/handler Stella Rowlett accomplished their OTCH (Obedience Trial Champion title) at the American Spaniel Club show under AKC Judge James Comunale. Cherry was the 13th American Cocker Spaniel to receive this prestigious award! We are so proud of you!

The OTCH is awarded to dogs with UD (Utility Dog) titles winning 100 points and a first place in Utility B and Open B, plus a third first-place win in either class, under three different judges. When you earn an OTCH, you realize that you and your dog have exceeded your highest expectations. Your dog is now one of the highest ranked dogs in the country!

There is a special bond that exists between a person and dog. Training and competing with one's dog strengthen that bond as evidenced by Stella and her Cherry. Earning this title is an honor—it represents many hours of hard work and dedication, as the team strives for perfection. Cherry accomplished this at the age of 12 ½ years, the oldest ever for a Cocker. She was Stella's first Novice A dog and together they worked earning numerous obedience titles including UDX 6 (Cherry being the first Cocker to do this). They are currently working towards Obedience Master 5.

Stella and Cherry will be traveling to Florida in December to complete in the AKC Obedience Classic, and they plan to attend the ASC Show in 2023. Along with Obedience, Stella and Cherry plan to compete in Rally Obedience. We look forward to seeing them in the competition ring and wish them lots of luck and success as they strive for more wins!







In 2021, Cherry Pie competed as the oldest dog at the AKC Obedience Classic. So despite being more than twice the average age (5.2 years) of all 247 competitors, she finished in seventh place in Utility class. Her accomplishments that year would be heady for dogs half her age, including all-time best scores and multiple legs in UDX and OM. At the end of the year, Cherry Pie was ranked #1 Cocker by OTCH points by Front & Finish Delaney's Rating System and Front & Finish First and Foremost Rating System.

At long last, in 2022 the team was able to compete at the NOC—a year that also saw Cherry complete her OM2, UDX4, OM3, and UDX 5 titles. At the NOC, she qualified in every exercise and made the cut for the Top 50 competition—the first Cocker to do so in recent years—and finished #32.

This year, of course, was highlighted by the team's participation in and triumph at the ASC Nationals. Not only did they qualify all three days but won High Combined Friday through Sunday and High in Trial on Sunday. On Sunday when Cherry Pie sailed over the last

jump, spectators cheered to celebrate the breed's 13th Cocker Spaniel OTCH. She is also the oldest Cocker to achieve this milestone at 12 years, 3 months, and 23 days.

The team did not slow down, as they went on to score more big wins in August and September and earned their UDX6 title—making Cherry the first Cocker to achieve this. They will cap the year by competing at the Obedience Classic in Masters Obedience in December and at Westminster in Masters Obedience in 2023.

Contrary to the belief of many, Stella feels senior dogs are "a joy to work with in obedience." Of course not every dog has Cherry Pie's stick-to-itiveness. Stella is convinced the little dog's attitude has been a huge part of her success. "She has always faced life with courage and happiness. She truly is a merry Cocker and knows no strangers. She has transcended the fate of a rescued pup with a broken leg—and flourished.

And, above all, and most importantly, Cherry Pie is always smiling when she is performing."


# TRAINING Cold Weather Activities

#### MORE SPORTING OPTIONS FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG.

Although I'm writing this article in late October, when we haven't fully hit winter, I know that the cold, dark days are coming for those of us on this side of the equator. I don't know about you, but my tendency is to want to do less in the winter months. Unfortunately, my dogs don't have the same tendency; they want to do as much in winter as they do during the summer. This has forced me to find creative ways to burn my dogs' energy without having to go outside. I thought I would share some of the things I like to do with my dogs in the house, so that you can also tire out your dogs without having to venture out into the winter weather.

The first activity I like to do is nosework, in case my previous articles on this subject haven't made that clear. This is a low-cost, easy to set up activity that challenges your dog's brain and sense of smell at the same time. The majority of the dogs in my house are trained in nosework, but at varying skill levels, so I will start with the easier hides and work the "baby" dogs, then gradually increase the difficulty of the hides as the skill level increases (a hide is the scented cotton swab that you hide and ask the dog to find). If you live in the land of cold and snow, winter is a great time to work on perfecting your dog's indication (how they tell you they've found the hide) as well as working through the challenge of teaching your dog to ignore distractors (toys, treats and even people food!). These things can be done with a minimal amount of equipment, so set up is easy and fast. If you are training a dog in nosework (or have done so previously), you



know that the indication requires ongoing maintenance so that it doesn't weaken or change into something you don't want, such as actively pawing or digging at the hide. If you haven't started teaching nosework yet—but feel like you might want to give it a try—you can hide a toy or treats around the house and ask the dog to search for those. Start off with simple hides, with the toy or treat in plain sight, and as the dog's skill level improves, you can make the searches tougher. I personally do not do a lot of food searches with my dogs, but they have been shown to be very effective at increasing your dog's drive to hunt for the cookie (or toy). If you have a dog that doesn't go wild for nosework, this might help with that.

The second activity that is great for indoor training is trick training. I've written an entire article about tricks and how to train some of the simpler ones, but the only limit with trick training is your imagination. I am constantly amazed at the tricks that people train their dogs to do. One of our very own (Katie Sharp) has taught her dog Ollie an entire workout routine—I am in awe of the time and skill it took to teach him all of the exercises and then to chain them together into one routine. Charlotte and I are currently working on putting plastic coins into a toddler's piggy bank, which requires a significant amount of skill and precision. Bowie's tricks are more like foundation obedience behaviours, but don't tell him that! He loves any kind of work, and the bonus is that I am getting great engagement with him, as well as cleaner exercises and straighter fronts and finishes. Some practical tricks that you might consider teaching your dog are to fetch the TV remote (always start with an old one that can be thrown out once your dog has mastered this exercise), teaching your dog to put away their toys and teaching your dog to help with laundry. Mine are always very enthusiastic about carrying my socks, although I will admit that it does occasionally turn into a game of tug of war before I can get the socks into the washing machine.

**If you really want to tire out your dog, try some shaping.** Shaping is the process of teaching your dog a behaviour in tiny little increments. Your dog basically has to guess what you want, and you tell them when they're right. It's the dog version of the "Hot-Cold" game, where a person tries to figure out a location or an item in a room, and you tell them when they're getting warmer

or colder based on their proximity to the location or item. In this case, though, we're doing this to get the dog to do what they want. For example, I love teaching my dogs to hit an Easy button or a tap light. When I first start to teach this, I use a yogurt container lid on the floor and shape them to touch it. Initially they might just look at it or sniff it, and I click this (using my clicker—some people use the verbal marker yes instead) and pay the dog. Most dogs will immediately look at it again, and I might pay that another time or two. But once they've figured





out that looking at it or sniffing it will pay, then I wait until they try something else to get the reward. What that next behaviour is will depend on your dog. If you've never done shaping, you might need to spend longer on step one, so they truly understand what they're being rewarded for. Once that is solid, you will wait and see what else they offer. Some dogs, especially dogs that are new to shaping, might just sit there once they've offered the look or the sniff, waiting to be told what to do. In this case I will do one of two things: I will reward them again for the look/sniff or I will wait for the tiniest movement towards the yogurt lid, mark that with the clicker or verbal marker, and then pay. We're talking possibly just a weight shift towards the lid, a look with the head lower than previously, or even a sniff where they might use one of their front feet to hold the lid in place. Remember that the end goal is the dog putting their paw on the yogurt lid, so ideally you will reward behaviours or movements that will eventually lead to that paw touch. If the dog is frozen, then that can mean that they're overwhelmed or really unsure about what to do, so I will pick up the lid, hold it behind my back, then put it back out, as if to reset the game. I find that Cockers tend to use their feet a fair amount, so they generally get around to stepping on the lid, or hitting it with their paw. For this I mark and give them a dog jackpot-10-15 treats in rapid succession, all while telling them how brilliant they are. Once the dog is solidly touching the yogurt lid, I bring out the Easy button and do some repetitions with the lid on top of the button. Then I remove the lid and wait for the dog to interact with the button. For a more thorough description of shaping, look up "101 Things To Do With A Box", which is often the first thing that most people

shape. Because shaping requires a lot of brainpower and problem solving for the dog, it is very tiring for them.

Canine conditioning is a great activity for when you're confined indoors. Please note that I am not a veterinarian, nor do I play one on TV, so I recommend getting cleared by your vet before starting any kind of fitness activities with your dog. There are lots of fitness products on the market made specifically for dogs (FitPaws or TotoFit products, for example), but many exercises can be done without special equipment. Conditioning can be as simple as doing some stretches using cookies, or as complicated as exercises involving various pieces of equipment. Cookie stretches are a great way to limber up your dog before doing vigorous activity such as agility or flyball. With the dog in standing, I hold the dog's collar and hold the cookie right in front of the dog's nose. Slowly move the cookie to the right, to encourage the dog to look over their right shoulder. Then move it to the left, easily. Come back to the middle and give your dog the cookie. Get another cookie and use it to have the dog look straight up as high as possible, come back to the middle, then use the cookie to have the dog look down as much as they can. Walking backwards is a great fitness exercise and is something I prescribe to most of my clients, regardless of what their issue is. I teach it using shaping. I start with a platform that is slightly raised and a different texture than the flooring. I start with the dog's back feet only on the platform and pay for that position a few times. I take one step back, which should cause the dog to step off the platform with the back feet. Now wait. If they so much as shift their weight like they might take a step backwards, mark and

pay them. Start them on the platform again, and take a step backwards, pulling the dog's feet off the platform. Wait again, for the dog to make any kind of movement with either of the back feet, then mark and pay that. As the dogs begin to understand what you're asking for, you will see them start reaching out with their back feet, looking for the platform. Gradually increase the distance that you ask the dog to back up to the platform. Backing up is a great way to increase or maintain strength in the back legs. If you're interested in conditioning exercises, there are a number of resources out there that can help. There's a book available with a variety of muscle exercises for dogs. It's called Gymnastricks by Carmen Mayer. That's a good place to start. Fenzi Dog Sports Academy has some canine conditioning classes that are offered virtually, or you can try and find a canine rehab practitioner in your area, to have your dog assessed and to get a personalized plan for your dog.

I hope I've given you some ideas for ways to pass the cold, dark days of winter. The real joy of training your dog is how the relationship between you grows. There

is no ceiling when it comes to the growth and depth of your relationship with your dog—just infinite ways to make it better.

#### **Billie Hayes**

She was born and raised as a country girl in Wilmington, Illinois. Even as a child, Billie owned a cocker spaniel and was involved in a rural 4-H group. Her interest in the sport of purebred dogs began in earnest in 1973 with the purchase of the foundation cocker spaniel bitch, CH Rinky Dink's Serendipity from Jean Peterson of "Rinky Dink Kennels." She was lucky enough, with the guidance of Jean, to breed a top winning and producing black/tan male named CH Chess King's Board Boss. During the 80's and 90's, he was certainly recognized as a dog who made a mark in this breed.

Billie worked in Veterinary Ophthalmology for eleven years, and then spent thirty-three years working for a large, human ophthalmology practice in the Phoenix area, retiring from the eye field in 2016.

After marrying David Hayes and expanding her interest to pointers, she has produced over 80 champions in the two breeds. Many of these were handled to their championship by Billie and often from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class. Now she enjoys her new project—a Papillon bitch by the name of CH Brevette Zero Sum Game!

After judging countless sweepstakes assignments, Billie began AKC judging in 1994 with her two breeds—cockers and pointers. Approved for twelve Sporting breeds and although not actively pursuing getting more breeds to judge, she enjoys judging these sporting breeds. Highlights of her judging career were the assignments at the American Spaniel Club Flushing Show and National Specialty in the past, plus many international assignments and cocker specialties from coast to coast.

Billie is a Lifetime Member of ASC, past ASC Board Member, and former member of the ASC Standards Committee. She currently serves as treasurer of the CSC Club of Arizona and is a member of the Scottsdale Dog Fanciers Association. She enjoys mentoring newcomers to our sport of dogs. Trinity's last litter produced the 2012 Flushing BOS to BOV winner owner-handled by me, Ch Conquest's This Is It! HT-ROM. Conquest dogs have been BOV and AOM at the Flushing show and BOV, BOS to BOB, and Select at the National in the parti and black variety. Conquest parti and black variety bred dogs have also been multiple group, best in specialty, and top 5 winners.

In the NOHS ring, I've learned not only to perfect my handling and grooming skills to be more competitive, but I've also learned the joy of having such a close bond with one's dog. I have also found invaluable help and knowledge from cocker and all-breed professional handlers and traveling to shows in different parts of the country has brought many friendships that I cherish dearly. Perseverance in the face of adversity and staying positive have allowed me to continue breeding and enjoying the sport. I've become an AKC licensed judge for cocker spaniels. I enjoy judging our beautiful breed and hope my decisions can help promote the qualities that I believe should stand out in our cockers. ### Let's begin Blair's Journey!

Tell us about Blair's introduction to her brothers, Sawyer (age 8) and Morgan (age 2), as well as her first few weeks adjusting to her new home and activities.

Blair's introduction into our family was extremely easy. I put her crates up several weeks ahead of time with her special blankets, quilts and toys inside. The boys were allowed to go in to smell but not stay. The crates belonged to Blair. They got used to her name before they even met her. I know great breeding and previous socialization had much to do with her transition into our home; she fit into our family like she had always belonged. Great breeders prepare their puppies and adults to be all they can be, and Karen Osper certainly has done that with Blair. We met Karen on her way to

She will lay down beside us so gently with her head on us and look up into our eves as if to tell us how much she loves us. She is such a sweetheart. She loves everyone, and I haven't found anyone or anything that seems to frighten or make her cautious. She takes everything on as an adventure. Noises do not bother her. Nothing seems to bother her at all. This may be because of her breeding, her previous home with Karen Osper, and being with her two sons. Nothing seems to bother her. I haven't found any type of noise that bothers her unless it is a crying puppy. If that happens, she is all ears!

### What are your future goals for Blair after certification and how will she fit into the role of therapy dog along with Sawyer and Morgan?

After she becomes a certified therapy dog, I plan to also continue her CGCA, CGCU, Rally and hopefully some barn hunt and Fast-CAT titles. She is a happy, fun girl, and I'd love to do whatever continues to make her happy. I know for sure that she loves all people and loves to bring joy, happiness, and a smile to them. Both my boys, Sawyer and Morgan, are certified therapy dogs,


