ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting and Reception will be held Saturday evening in the Marriott function room area. Details will be printed in the Judging Program. Each attendee will receive a ticket for a complimentary drink—wine, beer, soft drink, or water. Hard liquor and cocktails will be available for cash purchase.

ASC BOARD MEETING

The American Spaniel Club will hold its board meeting on Thursday, January 11, 2024, and it is open to all members. The location will be printed in the judging program.

BATHING

The American Spaniel Club provides three bathtubs with warm water for use between 5:00 am and 9:00 pm in the tack room.

CATALOG ADVERTISING

CATALOG SALES

Catalogs will be sold at the catalog table by Ring 1. Catalogs are \$20 each (exact cash is appreciated).

EARLY MORNING COFFEE/TEA

The American Spaniel Club will offer complimentary coffee and hot tea for early risers beginning at 6:30 am. We will also have a complimentary water station near the announcer's table.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

The concession stand will be open for seven hours during the show. The menu will include snacks, drinks, sandwiches, salads, and hot soup. To reduce exchange of money to a minimum, be prepared to bring small bills and change with you. Please note outside food and beverages are **not** to be brought into the show site, and there is a strict no alcohol policy for the facility.

FUTURITY

Not only will cocker spaniels have a Futurity on Saturday judged by John Zolezzi, there will also be an ASC Regional Specialty show on Friday. Cindy Lane, Patty Keenan and Calvin Ward will judge cockers at the specialty and Flushing Show.

HOURS OF USE

The facility will be unlocked at 5:00 am on Friday–Monday and will be locked at 11:00 pm Thursday–Sunday nights. All dogs and equipment are to be removed by 10:00 am on Monday, January 15, 2024.

HOTELS

There is a room block at the Marriott Knoxville Downtown (formerly the Holiday Inn World's Fair) upstairs from the show site. The rooms have floor to ceiling windows and all beds are king-size. There is now an elevator that goes from all guest room floors down to the same level as

PARKING

Parking is available at the host hotel. Self-parking is available for hotel guests at \$14/day and valet parking is available for \$28/day. Also, individuals attending the Flushing Spaniel Show may park in the hotel parking lot/garage for a fee of \$16/day.

RINGSIDE SEATING

SHOW STREAMING

Dog Show Video Pros will video BOTH rings and will offer subscriptions for live streaming. More information will be posted on the website. Individuals are prohibited from streaming during the show.

SMOKING

The entire facility is a No Smoking area.

TACK ROOM

Upon arrival, check-in with Marlene Ness, Tack Room Chair; exhibitors may begin moving in Thursday at 7:30 am. Bring plastic sheeting and shavings to put under your ex-pens. There may be a few 5' X 10' spaces allocated for exhibitors with 1 or 2 dogs. There will be an area for day crating but there will be no electricity available. The grooming space reservation form will be posted on the website and printed in the premium list.

UNLOADING

There is a small area for unloading at the far end of the building. Please unload your vehicle as quickly as possible and then move to a parking area before setting up. Marshalls will be on duty to keep traffic moving. Do not park in front of the building to unload. This is a driveway that can quickly get congested and city police do patrol the area and issue citations.

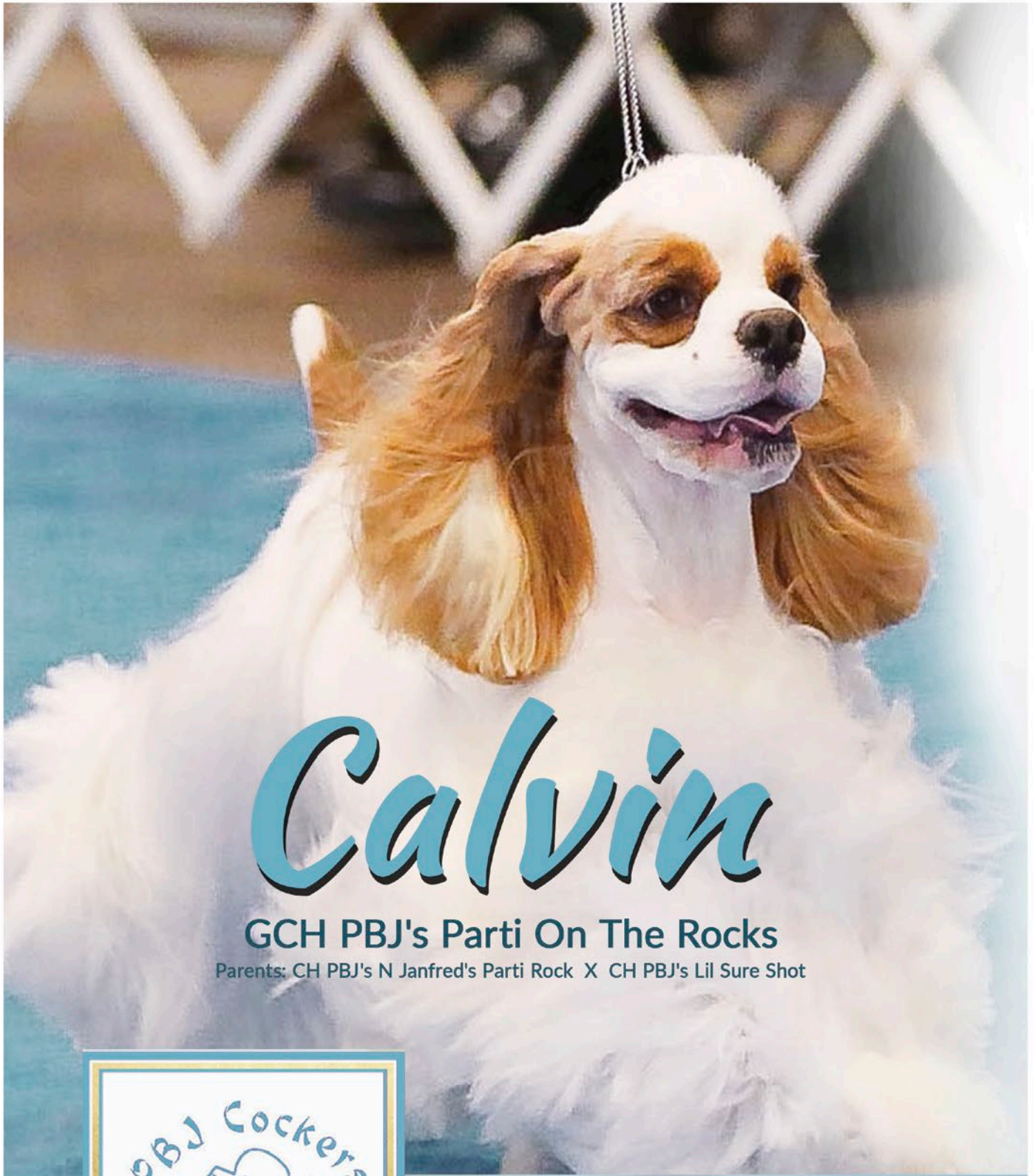

SCENT DETECTION

Know The Rules

SMIFF N GO AND MORE COMING SOON TO A BELOVED EVENT.

With scent work coming to next year's ASC National Specialty, I felt it would be a good time to review some of the rules, so that you can keep them in mind while training. With the number of scent work organizations offering competitions and titles, it can be very easy to get the rules wrong, as there is no single set of rules to cover them all. So a quick review will help you plan your training sessions between now and July 2024. The Regulations for AKC Scent Work are available on the AKC website (www.akc.org) as either a PDF download (free) or a printed booklet (nominal charge).

First of all, the odors that the AKC uses in their competitions are Birch (*Betula lenta*), Anise (*Pimpinella anisum*), Clove (*Eugenia caryophyllata*) and Cypress (*Cupressus sempervirens*). The Novice class uses Birch, the Advanced class uses Birch and/or Anise, and the Excellent class uses Birch and/or Anise and/or Clove. Cypress is used in the Master classes, but the ASC trial will only be offering Novice, Advanced and Excellent components. The AKC requires judges to prepare their swabs using two drops of essential oil on the head of a cotton swab. In comparison to the cooking method of preparing swabs used by NACSW and some other organizations, this is quite a bit of odor. If your dog hasn't practiced or competed on cotton swabs with direct drops of oil, I highly recommend you get them accustomed to it before traveling to Colorado. Talk to your instructor or training buddies to figure out a way to get the dogs introduced to the difference in amount of odor.

Something that can catch competitors unaware is **the rule regarding permissible collars, leashes and harnesses**. Organizations can differ slightly in this regard, so it's important to know what the AKC's position is on these items. The AKC policy is pretty straightforward with regards to equipment. Dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge.



No special training tools, such as electronic collars or no-pull harnesses, may be used during the search. Martingale collars are permitted. Handlers may attach a wearable camera (such as a Go Pro) to the dog's harness. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting

in the search area before and after their search. Any length of leash, including retractable leashes, are acceptable. Dogs may also wear accessories such as boots, jackets and/or sweaters and hair ties or bows.

Something I found interesting was **the requirement of a "Finish" call** for any searches with multiple hides. That is different than the organizations that I trial with (CKC, UKC and SDDA), and is something that I would need to work on with my guys. I admit that I typically only call "Finish" when doing a search with unknown number of hides. I'll be in Novice in July 2024, so no "Finish" call required at that level, but it's good to know for the future, and something easy to add to practice sessions.

So what does AKC Scent Work actually look like?

Well, there are four regular levels of competition—Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master, as well as a special level called Detective that teams cannot enter until they have at least one Master component title. Each level is comprised of four components—Container, Interior, Exterior and Buried. There is also a second stream called Handler Discrimination, where the dog searches for items scented by the handler, rather than searching for essential oils. In order to earn a component title, the team must pass that component three times, under any number of judges. So a dog would earn a Scent Work Container Novice (SCN) title by qualifying in three Novice Container searches, and the same holds true for the other components as well. A dog earns a level title by completing all four component titles at that level. In order to earn a Scent Work Novice title, a dog must earn an SCN, SIN (Interior), SEN (Exterior) and SBN (Buried). At the ASC trial, we are offering Novice, Advanced and Excellent levels, with all four components being offered.

Those are the basic rules that you need to know before entering the trial. All of the particulars are available in the AKC Regulations for Scent Work, as mentioned previously. For those that aren't competing in scent work, AKC Scent Work is spectator-friendly whenever possible, so you are welcome to come and watch some searches, just don't bring your dogs along. Photos and videos are encouraged, especially if you're watching friends compete, but they may not be shared with any other competitors running the same level and component until after that class is finished.

I would be foolish not to take this opportunity to ask all of you to **consider volunteering for the inaugural ASC Scent Work trial**. We will need a number of volunteers to help the trial run smoothly, especially timers, sheet runners and gate stewards. Volunteering gives you a great change to experience scent work up close and personal, and every person that has ever volunteered at a nosework trial where I was either competing or officiating has commented on how beneficial it was to their own nosework journey and about how much they learned from watching other teams. We can split the jobs into bite-sized shifts so that people aren't spending their entire day at the National without seeing everything it has to offer. If you are interested in volunteering, please contact me at kladckrs@gmail.com so I can maintain a list of people to call on as we approach the trial.

The other thing that I'd like to ask of you is to **consider sponsoring our prizes/rosettes**. Our big prizes this year will be beautiful boxed rosettes, in keeping with what is being offered across all of the venues at the National. We will also have rosettes for class placements and for new titles. If you are interested in sponsoring a



class in honour of or in memory of a special dog, please contact me at the email address above and I will coordinate that with you.

Last but not least, we will be offering a **Sniff 'n' Go on that Thursday**, giving folks an opportunity to get warmed up and ready for the trial. Entry forms for the event will be available in early 2024. I will be placing the hides, and I will be looking for volunteers to help keep things moving for that event as well.

I hope all of you are as excited about the inaugural ASC Scent Work trial, and I hope to see many of my sniffy friends there.

CHOOSING A STUD DOG

By DOUG JOHNSON, Clussexx Spaniels

CHOOSING A STUD DOG FOR YOUR BITCH IS AS IMPORTANT A DECISION AS CHOOSING YOUR BITCH WAS ORIGINALLY.

You have already made the decision that your bitch is of breeding quality, with an ideal temperament and is free of health concerns known to the breed. So, in order to properly select the best stud for her, the first thing you should do is take stock of the information you have gathered over the years about your bitch. Carefully analyze her strengths and weaknesses. Evaluate her conformation as objectively as possible. Does she have a weak top line but a nice front? How is her rear angulation? What about her coat texture? If you do not know what is wrong with your bitch, you will not know what you need to fix for future generations.

After all, that is really what you are trying to do—improve the breed by improving on your bitch. Breeders should always be striving to make the next generation better than the previous one. You will want to focus on one, maybe two, genetic traits that you would like to see improved in future generations and look for a stud dog that is strong in those areas. It is a delicate balancing act with no guarantee of success.

Next, you must research her pedigree—not just her sire and dam, but every dog that appears in at least the first three generations. The study of a pedigree in and of itself yields nothing, unless you study the individuals that make up that pedigree. Look for trends of head type, expression and eyes, balance and body and construction. This review will reveal where the strong trait in your bitch come from.

Do you notice a dog that is in the pedigree that is consistently producing the same traits? Use the pedigree to discover why and where your bitch's attributes come from both positive and the negative. You will want to capitalize on these positive links and try to avoid those less desirable characteristics (that you are planning to breed away from). An educated review of pedigrees often becomes a study of faults so be cautious. Remember, it should also be a study of virtues. Breeding dogs is a

blend of art and science so you often have to compromise to get what you want. Start now focusing on the positive and look for ways to minimize the negatives in the pedigree. Your goal should be to line breed on a dog that will give you more of what you like in the bitch you are trying to breed. The answer to stud dog selection is within the pedigree almost every time. Staying within a family of dogs will allow you to set a type and move your line forward.

This is also the perfect time to reach out to someone who has been in the breed longer than you to get some expert advice. If at all possible, you should consult with your bitch's breeder and ask them to spend some time with you going over various options so that you understand why one dog would be better for your bitch than another. They will know what their blood line can produce. In Cockers, you should reach out to a professional handler as these individuals helped develop this breed from the start. They have worked with all of the bloodlines and touched so many different dogs. Many of them have run breeding programs for larger kennels. They are a wonderful resource for you in the decision making process.

For your own knowledge, one of the best ways to gather information on dogs and bloodlines is by putting your hands on the dogs themselves. For most of us, this is best accomplished at specialties like American Spaniel Club. It is at specialties that pedigrees come to life! Don't be afraid to ask handlers or owners to see a dog you are interested in. People will be happy to have you go over them. You need to feel the dog you want to use especially in a heavily coated breed like American Cockers.

For me, my best bet is always to line breed on the dog in her pedigree that I like the most—whether it be a dog or a bitch. Yes, you'll double up on the faults produced in that line, but you will also double up on the virtues - and that's the name of the game. We have all heard the

expression, “You can’t make a silk purse out of a sow’s ear.”

The best success I have had has come from tight line breedings. Every breed is different and they all bring different challenges. It is one of your missions to know how far you can push the inbreeding coefficient. Sussex breeders are not afraid of father/daughter breedings to set type and have been successfully doing so for many years and generations. They stick VERY close to a pedigree. In Clumbers, we have never gotten that close, but we do grandfather/granddaughter breedings often. This is a common rule of thumb in breeding. Staying within a line and breeding to dogs with similar parentage is a good idea. It works to set a type, solidify a gene pool and retain quality. If we go out to a different family of dogs to open up our gene pool you can send the genetics into a free fall. You are going to lose consistency in the offspring but you should be able to use those dogs with the traits you like in your next generation. It is hard to predict what you will get in the offspring from these outcrosses, but they are necessary to keep your kennel moving forward. The progeny of that outcross breeding allows you to once again breed back to familiar parentage. Thus, opening up the pedigree just enough to continue comfortably line breeding.

If and when I go out to “new” blood, I look for a strong family. An established kennel that has been producing quality for many generation over many different kennels. Meaning their dogs mix well with others. This is a clue that tells me that I have a chance of top quality puppies if I use a dog from their kennel even if the type or look will be slightly different in the puppies. You then work to blend in those quality puppies to your breeding program in future generations. This outcross allows you to come back in again too. So, in the end it can be a win-win situation.

Here are some basic tips:

1. Know your bitch’s positive and negative traits and prioritize which are most important to this breeding.

Your chances of finding a stud that complements all of your bitch’s weak areas is low, but it makes sense to focus on dogs that don’t share her faults. Your best bet search for a dog that will correct your bitch’s faults when bred to other bitches with similar faults.

2. Learn as much as you can about the genetics of the traits you are trying to eliminate.

If your bitch is weak in topline and comes from a long line of dogs with poor toplines, you must find dogs with strong toplines to compensate for where she is weak. This is simple in theory but after several generations of the same fault you might be fighting an uphill battle. It can take several generations to reverse a trait.

3. Open your mind . . . take the blinders off!

Big winners are just that...big winners, not always great sires. So, while they may be the best in the ring today, they might not come from a pedigree that is useful or they might not produce the traits you need for your bitch. You want to use the BEST dog you can, not the one that has done the most winning.

Finally, picking a stud dog is really about evaluating your needs in your own bitch. Know what traits he brings to the table that complement your bitch and move your line in a positive direction. Go into the breeding knowing that the results of this mating may take a generation or two before you see the desired results. If you choose wisely, you will eventually see the results winning in the show ring.

The ideal stud in many cases is a dog that brings few faults to a pairing and lots of strengths. This dog gives strength to a pedigree and is a well-known producer of quality animals. He is generally a stallion of the breed with some exaggerations of type. He will cover your bitch’s faults and enhance her virtues. The best stud dog you can find will fill your eye with the picture of the breed. He will be a dog who has balance and substance and an air of quality. He will be a dog that is strong with traits that define the breed. He will be a dog you would be proud to own and one that wish you had bred yourself.

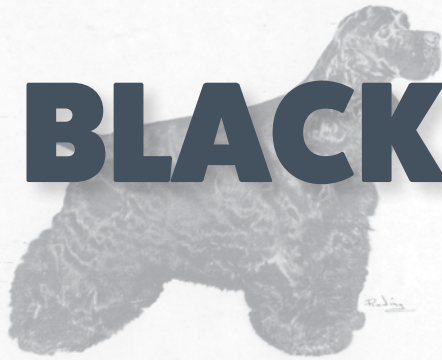

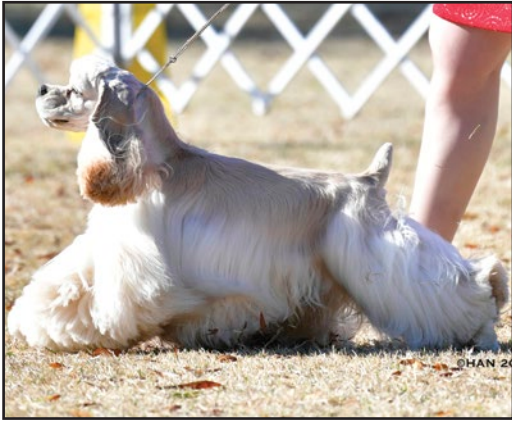

SARAH'S THERAPY DOG STORY

THIS ISSUE WE HONOR A SEASONED THERAPY DOG, SARAH, AKC CH UKC CH SPOSANS SERENDIPITY CD BN RM RAE OA AXJ MXP MJP2 THD RATO CGC TKN AND HER OWNER-HANDLER, SANDY ROLAND.

Sarah became a certified therapy dog when she was a year and a half old, and she is now 13 years old with almost 12 years of pet therapy experience as well as many performance titles. Sandy Roland has experience with other therapy dogs as well. Sandy is very close to becoming a Life Member of ASC. She will share with us information about this special girl named "Sarah" and their pet therapy journey.

MY BEGINNING EXPERIENCE WITH PET THERAPY

My mom had dementia and spent the last six years of her life happily living in a nursing home. I visited her 4-5 times per week and discovered how much mom enjoyed it when I brought one of my dogs along with me on those visits. Mom wasn't the only one who enjoyed their visits. It was impossible to walk from the front door of the facility to Mom's room without being stopped multiple times by residents and staff who were excited to see my cockers and wanted to pet them. Since most of my cockers were performance dogs as well as breed champions, I found that this experience was a great way to give them socialization and training with lots of distractions. This is what inspired me to spend time doing pet therapy. Sarah came along well after I'd lost my mom, but by then I was enjoying pet therapy and was determined to continue. The first indication that Sarah was going to be really special at pet therapy came about in a strange way. My husband John spent 14 years in the Navy during the Vietnam War, and he suffered from terrible nightmares. Sarah was probably not much more than a year old when we discovered that she could sense that a nightmare was coming, and she would gently lick John's face to wake him so he wouldn't suffer. He would cry because he was so grateful, and Sarah would just simply



snuggle up to him and calm him in her gentle way. I knew I had to get her certified so that she could help others the way she helped John.

JUGGLING PERFORMANCE AND PET THERAPY

I typically like to begin performance training with a basic obedience class. These basic skills are all you need



to train your dog for therapy work. Once the dogs have those basic skills, I get them tested for a CGC

title—this is the base needed for therapy dogs. After they have their CGC, I make arrangements to attend a Therapy Dog International (TDI) Test. By being part of this organization, my dogs are covered under their insurance in case there might be an accident at a facility or someone is hurt. But since I am still training my dogs for all of the many performance venues, doing therapy work gives me a great opportunity to train them under lots of distractions. Some of our patients loved it when I would ask Sarah to spin, sit and down, do recalls and do some of the fun tricks you can easily teach. Basic obedience and rally exercises look like fun tricks to people who aren't familiar with dog shows. For Sarah and me, it was a win-win situation.

SOME OF MY FAVORITE MEMORIES

I knew Sarah had a special gift for therapy work, but she proved it to me over and over again. She had this amazing way of knowing just what she needed to do for her patients. As mentioned above, she loved to perform for some of them, others she would simply lay next to them and rest her chin on their hand. One day we walked down the hall of a facility to visit a regular patient. We'd taken this walk many times, always walking past a woman who was strapped into a chair but seemed unconscious. On this particular day, Sarah made an abrupt change of direction and walked straight to this woman, pulling me along behind her. Sarah stood on her rear legs, resting her front legs on the woman's lap, and pushed her head under the woman's hands. The woman slowly lifted her head to gasps from nearby nursing staff, looked around at Sarah, and her face lit up as she smiled and said «Doggie!» I found out it was the first word she had said in several years. The staff were all in tears. Sarah got a whole lot of loving attention that day.

We do therapy work for a local hospice and spend anywhere from months to days visiting each patient prior to their death. Sarah has a special touch, and I swear she understands the situation. We were with one woman for several months, and while Sarah would cuddle with Jane Doe, I would read to her. When she slipped into a final coma, the family asked us to come each day. Sarah would lay next to Jane, who, even though she was unconscious, would slowly move her hand over Sarah. Her family, of course, were having a hard time, and one by one each would come lay their heads next to Sarah. She would nuzzle them and give her special love which seemed to bring them so much comfort. During this time a chaplain was there and she was moved to tears watching Sarah bring comfort to the whole family. Even though, at age 13, Sarah is no longer entered in performance events, she is beyond excited when the therapy leash comes off the hook, and she knows it's time to visit.

THE TYPES OF FACILITIES AND THERAPY VISITS

There are quite a lot of organizations who love to have therapy dogs. We helped one organization who arranged for us to be paired up with a lovely woman who had no family. She was in a nursing home but had never had any visitors until Sarah and I started coming to see her. It didn't take long before there were pictures of Sarah all over her room, and she would gleefully tell everyone that Sarah was her special friend. Pretty soon she had arranged to have treats waiting for Sarah each week. In an ironic twist of fate, Mary was a wonderful support to me emotionally while my husband was in hospice care.

We have also gone on visits to facilities as part of my church mission, and with my kennel club to give performance demonstrations. Most recently Sarah and I have been working with a local hospice, and we visit facilities and sometimes private homes. One of our home visits was with a woman in her forties, but who had the joyful mind of a ten year old. She loved Sarah with all her heart. We had the pleasure of visiting with Penny for nine months. In the end Sarah shared my sorrow

and helped me to deal with our loss. We have had a couple new patients since then, and our current patient has turned out to be the eighty year old mother of a man in hospice care. After all, we treat the whole family. Sarah would have it no other way.

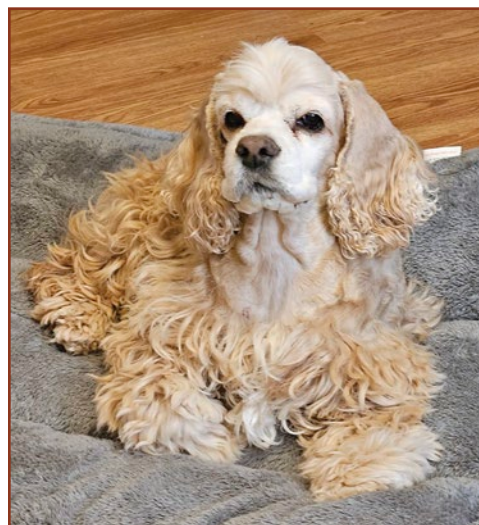
PLANS FOR FUTURE THERAPY DOGS

Sarah was bred one time and gave me my wonderful Becca, an AKC and International champion who is following in Sarah's footsteps earning many performance titles along the way. Becca had earned her CGC and taken an additional class on therapy work that included familiarization with walkers, wheelchairs, and other things dogs need to be comfortable with when visiting nursing homes. I was ready to start visiting to get Becca comfortable and then get her TDI testing when Covid hit the world, and we all went into lockdown. Her therapy career went on hold, but I hope to get her tested next spring.

In July 2022 I was blessed with a new puppy, Hope. She has a very sweet nature, and when she grows up, I think she is going to be a great therapy dog. I'm looking forward to many more years of doing pet therapy visits.

ENCOURAGING OTHERS TO GET INVOLVED IN THERAPY WORK

Therapy dogs are those who have a sweet disposition, who love interacting with all kinds of people, and are willing to stay calm at times when things can be stressful. If your cocker is like that then I really encourage you to think about getting involved. Most cockers love to please and will enjoy the attention they get from their patients. There are not enough dogs available to meet current needs. The hospice group I volunteer for is so in need of therapy dogs that they will pay for your testing and pay your annual TDI dues. There are also organizations looking for dogs who love children to visit hospitals and schools. Many hospitals are looking for therapy dogs for a variety of reasons. Trust me, the mental rewards you will get from volunteering are beyond wonderful. Both of my husbands died from lung cancer, and they each chose to have hospice care at the end of their lives so they could go peacefully in our home with our dogs cuddled around them. It made such a huge difference in my life so Sarah and I chose to help in this way to give back to this wonderful organization. I know what the



families are going through which can bring them help, too. You may prefer to work with other organizations. Either way, take a CGC class and get your dog certified, you will be so glad you took that chance.

HOW THERAPY WORK MAKES A DIFFERENCE TO THE DOGS

Cockers and Border Collies have one thing in common: they love to have a job. A cockers' job can be as simple as being in charge of giving out kisses and cuddles, but it brings them pleasure. As an example: Becca tore her iliopsoas muscle this past August. Treatment is crate rest for as long as six months. While she's been crated Becca has gotten very depressed because she can't do her job. Normally she is training for Rally, Obedience, and running in F-CAT trials on a weekly basis, plus being my personal lap warmer. She was such a happy girl. It's been heartbreaking to watch her become depressed, not having a way to explain to her. Sarah stepped up and made it a point to curl up next to Becca's crate. I'm happy to report a recent ultrasound shows the muscle

knitting together, and Becca is allowed house freedom again. She's not allowed to train or run for several more months, but she can do therapy work and it's giving her a purpose. Once again my happy little girl is bringing me toys to share and warming my lap. Therapy work can be done by dogs who don't have a chance for any other type of job, and they will love it.

A LIFE-LONG INSPIRATION

My pet therapy journey started accidentally, by taking my dogs along to visit my mom, but the gift was mine. Pet Therapy work has blessed me with so many rewards in my life. I've met and become friends with many people, and I've bonded in such a special way with my dogs. Age has robbed me of the ability to run around an agility course with my dogs, but therapy work has filled that hole in my life. I have the satisfaction of knowing Sarah and I have brought peace to so many people in their final days and given the gift of friendship to some very lonely people who gave back the gift to me as well.

Therapy work enriches lives—both those of the receiver as well as the giver. It's a wonderful experience for you and your dog. Give it a try—you could be gifted with some amazing rewards.

CONCLUSION

IMMUNE MEDIATED HEMOLYTIC ANEMIA - A SILENT KILLER

WHAT IS THE FOUNDATION DOING?

Immune Mediated Hemolytic Anemia (IMHA) is a devastating disease that is caused by the formation of autoantibodies against red blood cells, resulting in a rapidly progressing anemia with a mortality rate of over 50% in the affected animals. In many cases the signs of the disease are common with other conditions and may easily be overlooked or not observed quickly enough by the owner, leading to a delayed diagnosis and a less favorable prognosis. Some of these signs include that the dog tires more easily, appears lethargic, presents pale or grayish gums, may be disoriented or faint due to lack of oxygen to the brain. The disease is complex and many questions still remain unanswered. Possibly the most important question is what triggers the body to stop recognizing and attack its own red blood cells.

Although IMHA affects all spaniels, the literature indicates that cockers have a 7-fold increased risk of developing this disease. This breed disposition suggests that there could be a genetic component to developing IMHA. Unfortunately, up to date published genome-wide genetic studies have failed to show any genetic variants that could be associated with the disease. As a result, this has prevented the development of a test that could predict an individual's dog risk of developing the disease and aid the breeder in their breeding program.

It is worth mentioning that this disease occurs naturally in both dogs and humans sharing many characteristics and treatments. In humans it is referred to as Autoimmune Hemolytic Anemia (AIHA). In both cases, autoantibodies attack the red blood cells leading to an anemia as well as a disseminated coagulation. In humans, the immune response molecules, IgG and IgM have been identified on the surface of the red blood cell triggering a complement activation and subsequent hemolysis. Although the incidence is 10-fold higher in dogs than in humans, the mechanisms of the disease is

less understood, yet this makes the canine model optimal to further understand and improve treatments. The treatments are shared by both species and comprise the use of immunosuppressive drugs, anti-thrombotic drugs, with splenectomy and plasmapheresis suggested in dogs.

Research has approached this disease from various points as it presents an Immune, a Genetic, and a Cellular component. In 2020 Dr. Steven Friedenber, who is an immunologist and geneticist at the University of Minnesota, published a study identifying altered levels of the mRNA of various blood coagulation proteins. This work sparked a research project that is being carried out by Dr Tracy Stokol at Cornell University as the principal investigator. **This project is presently supported by the ASC Foundation.** The study is pursuing the correlation of the increased mRNA levels of the Plasminogen Activation Inhibitor-1 (PAI-1) with the presence of the protein itself, along with the severity/outcome of the disease since this supports the hypothesis that altered fibrinolysis contributes to thrombosis and disseminated intravascular coagulation in dogs.

We hosted a webinar with Dr. Stokol which is available on our website at <https://asc-f.org/seminars/>. Continuing with the quest to further understand this life-threatening disease, Dr. Friedenber in collaboration with Dr. LeVine and Dr. Viall are working to improve the immunophenotyping of the canine IMHA to understand the triggers of the disease and improve the treatment strategies.

Another very important project they are carrying out is to identify the genetic risk factors of the disease by continuing the Genome Wide Association Study (GWAS) in the area of the genes responsible for the immune response.

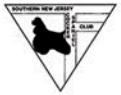

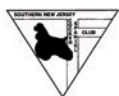

HOW WAS WINNING THE FUTURITY IMPORTANT TO YOU AS A BREEDER/OWNER?

As a life member, I believe that the Futurity represents my most valuable wins in the 35 years I have been breeding! Winning the Futurity, and exhibiting in the Futurity are the goals for every litter I whelp here at Toybox. It is a way to compare my breeding program to the best cockers shown in the US, and allows me to critically evaluate each puppy I have shown there.

WHY DO YOU BELIEVE ASC MEMBERS SHOULD RELISH A FUTURITY WIN AND HOW CAN THEY UTILIZE THE FUTURITY TO SHOW OFF THEIR BREEDING PROGRAM?

Futurity wins are extraordinary but winning is not always the goal. It is equally valuable to be able to watch the best puppies in our breed and compare the sires and dams that I believe move us closer to the standard. And I like to keep track of the health status for the parents of puppies I watch there every year. I have been fortunate enough to win three Best In Futurity awards and numerous others for variety and classes, and they are my absolutely best memories from ASC. Those are also the only rosettes I ever keep! I strongly believe that ALL ASC breeders should be nominating their bitches and puppies to demonstrate their commitment to breeding better cockers. Only by the Futurity process can you advertise your commitment to health testing every litter. The Futurity allows you to stack your breeding program up against the very best in our breed and compare lines and crosses that might help you reach even more Futurity wins. I also eagerly anticipate throwing Futurity parties, where I can get more feedback from other breeders and enjoy their comments. This year, Regina and I will be hosting a party for Ch. Toybox Bunny Hop, whose sire and dam were also Futurity winners in the past.

HOW WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE THE FUTURITY RETURN TO THE PROMINENT AND PRESTIGIOUS EVENT IT USED TO BE?

I don't believe that the Futurity can ever return to the large numbers of entries in past years. Fewer cocker breeders and litters is a trend that is not probably going to be reversed in my lifetime. Despite these lower entries, I believe that the Futurity classes will remain the strongest classes at ASC. If we all commit to nominating our litters and exhibiting those puppies, winning the Futurity will always be a prestigious honor, and it should remain a prominent goal for each of our breeding members.

RULES FOR COCKER SPANIEL FUTURITY STAKE

BREEDERS OF ENTRIES for the Futurity MUST BE American Spaniel Club, Inc. (ASC) members in good standing through all steps of the Futurity process (have annual dues paid, no suspensions). Any suspension of a breeder or co-breeder by AKC and/or ASC shall automatically disqualify the breeder(s) from participation in the Futurity, to include any nominations for bitches owned, co-owned or leased during the suspension and any puppies bred or co-bred during the suspension. This includes disqualifying any existing bitch nominations or puppy enrollments and also disallows any future bitch nominations or puppy enrollments during the suspension period. No puppy will be eligible for futurity enrollment from any litter which was bred or co-bred by a suspended member, regardless of ownership. Owners (if other than the breeder) of futurity puppy entries are not required to be ASC Members.

Nominations and enrollments shall be sent to the Futurity Chairman only on the forms issued by the ASC. You may photocopy the forms. The forms state the required payment and information. Incomplete forms will be returned. Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds, checks drawn on U.S. Banks and U.S. Money Orders or through PayPal via the ASC Website. Checks on Foreign Banks for U.S. funds are not acceptable and if sent will be returned along with the Futurity Form. Checks that do not clear the bank **MUST BE REPLACED WITH MONEY ORDERS PLUS BANK CHARGES** for returned checks. There will be no refunds.

Steps which must be taken to Futurity nominate are as follows:

BITCH NOMINATION

1. Owner and co-owner(s) to include lessees of the dam to be nominated must be American Spaniel Club, Inc. (ASC) members in good standing as of the date of breeding and through all steps of the Futurity process.
2. The bitch must be properly nominated prior to whelping.
 - a. Nominations made between January 1 and June 30 inclusive for January Futurity.
 - b. Nominations made between July 1 and December 31 inclusive for July Futurity.
3. Nominations may be submitted either through the postal service (USPS) or electronically.
 - a. **Postal Service (USPS):** The nomination envelope must bear a post office cancellation stamp with a date prior to the whelping date. **POSTAGE METER IS NOT VALID** for a postmark date.

If the postmark is not legible or is missing, the nomination will be considered to be postmarked two days prior to the date received.

- b. **Electronically:** Forms may be submitted electronically to the Futurity Chairman and must be received prior to the whelping date. Payment must be made through PayPal via the ASC website and must be made prior to the whelping date. **POSTMARK DATE WILL BE CONSIDERED THE DATE OF PAYMENT.**
4. A fee of **\$10.00** for each bitch nominated must accompany the form, in accordance with the instructions stated on the form. If the bitch's due date is such that she may whelp in either the January or July Futurity, you should nominate her for both and include a fee of \$20.00.
 5. Both sire and dam **must be at least 2 years old** before the breeding takes place.
 6. **Health Testing requirements:**
 - a. OFA or PennHip certification must be done on or after the age of 2 for both sire and dam.
 - b. Eye exams must be done on or after the age of 2 for both sire and dam and annually thereafter. Exams dated prior to the age of 2 or more than 12 months prior to the date of breeding **will not be accepted**. A clear eye exam after the age of 8 for both sire and dam will be accepted as permanently clear.
 7. **Documents which must accompany the nomination form: (All documents must be complete and legible.)**
 - a. Photocopies of the individual AKC Registration Certificates for both sire and dam.
 - b. Photocopies of the Certification of clear eyes from a Board certified ophthalmologist or similar designation in the case of foreign entries for both sire and dam.
 - c. Photocopies of OFA or PennHip certification for normal hips for both sire and dam or similar certification in the case of foreign entries for both sire and dam.
 - d. If sire and/or dam are listed in the ASC Health Registry, it is not necessary to forward copies of the eye or hip certification for that animal.
 - e. If the bitch is leased, send photocopies of the AKC Lease Acknowledgement received from the American Kennel Club.

PUPPY NOMINATIONS

1. Only puppies from nominated bitches, whelped after date of nomination, are eligible.
2. No puppy will be eligible for futurity enrollment from any litter which was bred or co-bred by a suspended member, regardless of ownership.
3. Owners (if other than the breeders) of futurity puppy entries are not required to be ASC members.

4. Enrollment of any puppies must be made ON OR BEFORE November 1 for the January Futurity and May 1 for the July Futurity.
5. Enrollments must be made on individual forms issued by ASC and a payment of **\$10.00** per puppy is required. Forms and payment may be submitted to the Futurity Chairman either through the postal service (USPS) or electronically.
6. The form will state the complete requirements, including, the name of the puppy, the name of the sire and dam, date of birth, sex, variety and individual AKC Registration Number must be given. Puppies bred outside the United States by ASC members may provide a registration number from an AKC recognized international registry, if an AKC number is not yet obtained.
7. **Late Enrollment:** You may make a late puppy enrollment for a **TOTAL fee of \$25.00 per puppy**, provided all other requirements are met. Late enrollments may be made through the postal service (USPS) or electronically. **LATE ENROLLMENTS DO NOT GO BY POSTMARK; THEY MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE FUTURITY CHAIRMAN BY DECEMBER 1 FOR JANUARY FUTURITY AND JUNE 1 FOR JULY FUTURITY.**

ENTERING THE FUTURITY CLASS

1. The breeder(s) of the puppy **MUST STILL BE A CURRENT MEMBER OF ASC** in good standing.
2. Each puppy shall be entered in one of the Regular Classes and, in addition, the entry blank must also be designated "Futurity Stake".
3. A final payment of \$15.00 for each puppy to be shown in the Futurity shall be made to the Superintendent of the Show before the closing of entries for the Show, at which time the Name, AKC Number, Date of Birth, Breed, Sex, Variety and Class of each puppy must be given on the Regular AKC approved Entry Blank, together with the payment of the Regular Entry Fee.
4. The ASC is not responsible for any errors made on the Entry Blank and no refunds will be made by ASC.

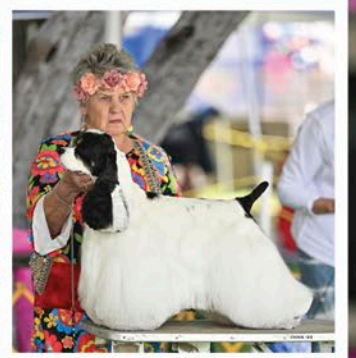
