**NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**  
National Only

**Stud Dog:** For stud dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud dog must be entered in the appropriate Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. The owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based upon their merits. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brood Bitch:** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. In accordance with AKC rule Ch 11, Sec 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch Class.

**Brace:** The entry fee for a Brace as a UNIT is \$40. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competitions must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No 1", "Brace No 2", etc. Brace as an additional entry - \$30.00 for the unit.

**Team:** Same as Brace Class, see information above and substitute "Team" for "Brace". - A team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**  
Classes for Dogs and Bitches

**Veteran:** open to all dogs 7 years old and older

Note: Chapter 11, Sec on 8, of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males & spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Classes at specialty shows. Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition.

**Field: (National & Regional)** Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches that have earned working dog (WD) or working dog excellent (WDX) titles from their Parent breed clubs have received a qualifying score at any AKC Hunting Test for Flushing Spaniels or received a placement at an AKC Field Trial. Classes to be judged after Winners but before Best of Variety of Breed. Winners to compete for Best of Variety if undefeated.

## Obedience Trials & Rally Trials

"Dog" means either sex. A dark green ribbon will be given for qualifying scores. Classes with jumps will be judged in ascending order beginning at 4." Entries must include jump height for classes requiring jumps. "According to Chapter 1, Sec on 27 of AKC Regulations, entries will be limited. When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX, Preferred UDX, and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Preferred Open or Preferred Utility class, the Preferred UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. If any Advanced B, Excellent B or Masters Class is full, the RACH Class will be considered full.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. **FUTURITY STAKE**  
**Judge: Maureen Jewett**

***The Futurity Stake is a showcase for the breeder's effort.***

BREEDERS OF ENTRIES for the Futurity MUST BE American Spaniel Club, Inc. ("ASC") members in good standing through all steps of the Futurity (have annual dues paid, no suspensions). Any suspension of a breeder or co-breeder by AKC and/or ASC shall automatically disqualify the breeder from participation in the Futurity, to include any nominations for bitches owned, co-owned, or leased during the suspension and any puppies bred or co-bred during the suspension. This includes disqualifying any existing bitch nominations and disallows any future bitch nominations during the suspension period. No puppy will be eligible for futurity entry from any litter which was bred or co-bred by a suspended member, regardless of ownership. Owners (if other than the breeder) of entries are not required to be ASC members. Bitch Nominations shall be sent to the Futurity Chairman only on the forms issued by the ASC. You may photocopy the forms. The forms may be submitted electronically to the Futurity Chair. The Bitch Nomination forms state the required payment and information. Incomplete forms will be returned. Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds, (Checks drawn on U.S. Banks and U.S. Money Orders only). There will be no refunds. Checks on Foreign Banks for U.S. funds are not acceptable and if sent will be returned along with the Futurity Form.

The steps which must be taken to Futurity nominate are as follows:

**1. Bitch Nomination.**

- a. The dam of the litter must be owned or leased by an ASC member(s).
- b. The dam must be properly nominated prior to whelping (between July 1 and December 31 inclusive).
- c. Only puppies from nominated bitches, whelped after date of nomination, are eligible to be entered in the Futurity Class.
- d. The Bitch Nomination envelope must bear a post office cancellation stamp with a date prior to the whelping date. Postage Meter is not valid. If the postmark is not legible or is missing, the date mailed will be considered to be 2 days prior to receipt. Electronic submissions to the Futurity Chair are dated the day of receipt.
- e. A fee of \$30 for each bitch nominated must accompany the form or be paid on the ASC Webpage, in accordance with the instructions stated on the Bitch Nomination form. If the bitch's due date is such that she may whelp in either the January or July Futurity, you should nominate her for both. Nomination for both January and July requires a \$40 fee.
- f. Both sire and dam must be at least 2 years old before the breeding takes place.
- g. Health testing must be done on both the sire and dam as described on the Bitch Nomination form.
- h. If the bitch is leased, photocopies of the AKC Registration and Lease Form filed with the AKC must be provided at the time of Bitch Nomination.

**2. Futurity Class Entry.**

- a. Entries shall be made in the name of the OWNER (S), who need not be a member of ASC.
- b. A payment of \$20 for each puppy to be shown in the Futurity Class shall be made to the Superintendent of the Show before the closing of entries for the Show on the Regular AKC approved Entry Blank. In addition, the entry must include payment for the Regular Class Entry.
- c. Each puppy shall be entered in one of the Regular Classes and, in addition, the entry blank must also be designated entry into the "Futurity Stake."
- d. The BREEDER(S) of the puppy MUST STILL BE A CURRENT MEMBER OF ASC on the date of the Futurity.
- e. The money received by ASC from the nomination of bitches shall be divided as follows: 40% retained by ASC for the expenses of the Futurity Stake, 10% for the Best Puppy in Futurity (50% of this will be awarded to the puppy's owner; 50% to the breeder), 5% for Best Opposite Sex to Best In Futurity Puppy (50% of this will be awarded to the puppy's owner, 50% to the breeder), 10% for Best Puppy in each Variety, 5% for Best Opposite Sex to Best in each Variety.
- f. The money received by ASC from the puppy Futurity Entry shall be divided as follows: 40% of the total for expenses for the Futurity Stake retained by ASC to cover expenses, 40% of the total for the Best in Futurity winner, and 20% of the total to the Best Opposite to Best in Futurity winner.

**3. Judging**

The judging in each sex and Variety shall be as follows: 6 to 9 months; 9 months and over but not exceeding the age limitations of the Futurity. Each sex, each age group in each Variety shall be judged separately. Following the judging of each age and sex group of each Variety for best in each group above, the six shall be judged, first for best of each respective Variety, and Best Opposite Sex to each Variety, and from the final three shall be selected the Best Puppy in the Futurity. Any dog of opposite sex to Best in Futurity, if undefeated within their Variety, shall compete for Best Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity. The BREEDER of Best of each Variety and Best opposite Sex of each Variety shall receive a Certificate from the ASC. Money awards will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog.

### **PROUD BREEDER'S FUTURITY CAMPAIGN**

ASC National Show - \$1000 will be awarded to the Best in Futurity (BIF) winner and \$500 to the Best of Opposite (BOS) to BIF winner.

These awards will be presented to the breeder(s) of the BIF and BOS to BIF winners.

To promote continued health testing in Cocker Spaniels, at each National Specialty all of the breeders' names of futurity nominated bitches from both the January and July futurities are combined in a hat and two names are drawn. The ASC foundation awards the winners \$250.00 towards eye exams and \$150.00 towards hip x-rays. All monies will be sent to the winners upon ASCF receiving proof of exams. Winners need not be present to win.

These rewards are to encourage Cocker Spaniel participation in the OFA CHIC Health Registry Program by creating a reward for the Sire and Dam of the three Futurity Best of Variety Winners at the Cocker Spaniel National Specialty and the American Spaniel Club Flushing Spaniel Show. The ASC Foundation will mail \$150 to the Owner of the Sire for each Futurity Best of Variety winner and \$150 to Owner of the Dam of the Futurity Best of Variety winner, once the following conditions are verified by the ASC Foundation. The requirements for this reward are: the Sire/Dam of the Futurity Best of Variety has a valid CHIC number, and the Sire/Dam has completed a satisfactory CAER exam within the previous 12 months, as documented on the OFA webpage.

#### **The Star Premier Award (Friday-Saturday)**

A trophy and rosette will be awarded to the cocker who is entered in all Premier classes (regular or preferred) during the 4 days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National and has the fastest accumulated times (points under course time) from qualifying scores. Cockers in both regular and preferred classes are eligible, but the Preferred competitors will be scored using the same course time as the regular classes.

#### **The CCCC Award (Thursday-Saturday)**

This award is offered by the Capital City Cocker Club to Cocker Spaniels under the age of 7 showing at the Masters level in Standard, Jumpers and Premier over the first three days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National agility trial. This award encompasses all the aspects of agility; speed, consistency and handling. The winning score will be calculated based on MACH points (points under course time) earned in each regular class, plus 5 additional points for a double qualifying score. Premier points will be calculated in the same fashion, but with 10 additional points awarded for a qualifying score in both Standard and Jumpers. Cockers in both regular and preferred classes are eligible, but the Preferred competitors will be scored using the same course time as the regular classes. The winning Cocker and handler will receive a statue trophy with an engraved plaque.

#### **The Bailey Award of Agility Excellence (Thursday-Sunday)**

This award is offered by Vivian Hudson (Bar-Bax Cockers) in memory of Bailey (MACH16 Bar-Bax's Makin' New Waves, CD, MXB5, MJS5). A crystal trophy, rosette and \$100 will be awarded to a Cocker Spaniel 7 years or older entered in both Master Standard and JWW classes (Preferred cockers are not eligible) who accumulates the most points during the total days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National agility trials. Points are accumulated by calculating each MACH point earned (points under course time) plus 10 points per Double Qualifying score per day. This award is to acknowledge consistency, speed and stamina of an older Cocker Spaniel who is showing and performing well in the Master level classes at their regular jump height.

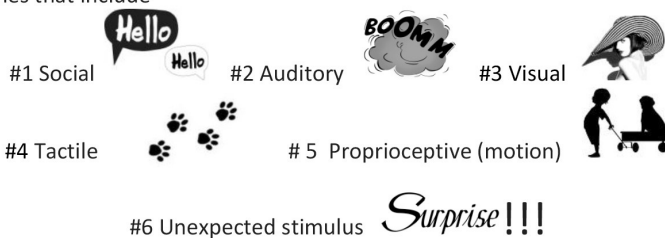

## Welcome to the AKC Temperament Test!

Presently, there are 199 breeds of dogs recognized by AKC. Each breed is unique in physical appearance and temperament. The temperament of any dog is an important characteristic with it being the dog's natural predisposition to react a certain way to a given stimulus. The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) has been developed to bring focus to and provide a meaningful evaluation in the assessment of the temperaments of our canine companions.

The ATT is open to dogs at least one-year of age of all breeds and mixed breed dogs. It is a noncompetitive, pass-fail test that screens for fear, shyness, inability to recover, and lack of cooperation. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression. Desired canine traits include emotional stability, inquisitiveness, appropriate social behavior, manners and recovery from an upsetting situation within a reasonable amount of time.

The ATT tests how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli with dogs tested in 6 categories that include



ATT tests are administered by AKC licensed or member clubs in conjunction with AKC events such as dog shows, trials, or as stand-alone tests. Dogs are required to take the ATT test under two different AKC evaluators and, if they pass they earn the ATT title with the suffix 'ATT' after their names. Dogs who do not pass the test may retest when they are ready.

All dogs entered in the AKC Temperament tests should have an AKC or FSS registration number or a Canine Partners Listing number or Purebred Alternative Listing Number. **JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once.

The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

**THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
