The standard room with 2 queen beds is Wednesday and Thursday and Sunday \$104, Friday and Saturday \$154. Standard room with 1 king bed is \$108 for Wednesday and Thursday, \$158 Friday and Saturday. One time pet fee is \$30 non-refundable charge for 1-2 dogs; \$60 for 3-4 dogs (maximum of 4 dogs). No dogs allowed in suites, food or beverage areas, pool, or fitness center. Breakfast is included in room rate. Approximately 15 miles away from Purina Farms Event Center.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure they carry proof that each dog in their possession is properly vaccinated, and each is healthy and showing no signs of illness (e.g., coughing) before arriving onsite at Purina Farms.

Don't forget to make a reservation for the ASC Foundation Dinner Friday night! Wear your pajamas for Pajama Bingo! \$45 per person. Lots of prizes, raffles and auctions (included with ticket price)! Sign up at the ASC Store, click the Foundation Dinner icon!

Instinct Testing will be available each day during the show! Contact Kaye Wynn-Givens at the Instinct Testing Table, set up between Conformation and Agility, for a flyer!

The Service Building will not be available each day between the hours of 7am and 5 pm. There will not be access to Showers, Rest Rooms or the Dog Bathing room during these hours. The building will be reserved for Interior ScentWork searches. Plan to shower or bathe dogs either early or late.

Important! The North Entry Door to the Tack Room will not be available for unloading or entrance to Grooming! The rear one third of the Grooming building is reserved for ScentWork use for Buried searches and ScentWork crating.

No access, except ScentWork, will be allowed through that door. Exhibitors should UNLOAD through the South Entrance, down the hall with the Bathing Stations ONLY. The South entry door is across from the RV Parking lot.

Instinct Testing will be available each day during the show. Contact Kaye Wynn-Givens at the Instinct Testing table, between Conformation and Agility, for a flyer!

The North Tack Room door and the rear 1/3 of the Grooming Building is reserved for ScentWork and their exhibitors. Unloading must be through the South door, through the hall with the bathing stations. There will not be access to Grooming or for Unloading through the rear door or reserved ScentWork area of the Grooming Building.

The Service Building RestRooms, Showers and dog bathing area will be CLOSED each day from 7am to 5pm. The Service Building is reserved for Interior ScentWork Searches during these hours. Shower either early or late, as there won't be access to that Facility between those hours.

The rear one third of the tack/grooming room will not be available to Conformation or Agility exhibitors during the show. The rear doors will not be available for unloading, as this area is designated for ScentWork only. Please unload through the bathing hallway or via the side doors. Conformation unloading will not be allowed through the ScentWork area, which is reserved for the Buried ScentWork trials.

There will be an ASC Town Hall Meeting on Friday, at the completion of judging! Lots of important news and recognition of our new members, so plan to attend!

★ NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ★

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once.
